Sold First: Full racks of flowers or full pallets of produce or full bins of anything sold in lots.

Sold Second: Any lots sold as 4 or more

Sold Third: Any lots of 2 or more baskets or hanging baskets

Corn is sold by the dozen

Berries sold by pint or quart

Pumpkins, melons, and squash sold by the piece or by the bushel

Cabbage, cauliflower and broccoli sold by the head.

Sweet Onions sold by piece or by the box

Spring onions, radishes, red beets, carrots, and Indian corn sold by the bunch or box.

Potatoes sold by the bag or box

Flower pots sold by the pot.

Flower flats sold by the flat.
