Engineering! Crafts! Games! At every event we will do either an engineering activity or craft and then play a board game. Have a favorite game? Bring it!


Parents/Guardians of 4-H Members are welcome to stay, but it is not required. Parents/Guardians of Cloverbuds are required to attend.






CLEVERBUDS

Pointy side up, fold one side of the triangle bottom up at an angle. Make the other side match. Fold the pointed side down.

Fold the triangle in half; open it back up so you can see the crease.




Flip over (you can use tape to help keep the ears flat if you'd like.) Make your cat's face and you're done!




