*Enrollment is \$75 for the FIRST category chosen within Wayne County/Team Region. If you choose more than one category, any additional registrations will be \$60.

Category 1: Lake Ontario Fruit Team. Small fruit and tree fruit information, meeting notices, roadside marketing information, and the **Fruit Notes Newsletter** series, timely email messages, and reduced program fees. **Fruit Facts** and **Harvest Facts** are an additional fee.

Category 2: NWNY Dairy/Livestock/Field Crops Program. A Viticulture Extension Specialist will provide you with important and timely information through a wide variety of means to help you produce the best crop possible, and as efficiently as possible. With your enrollment, you will receive: **The Finger Lakes Vineyard Update** email messages, the semi-monthly **Finger Lakes Vineyard Notes Newsletter** (Paper copies of **Finger Lakes Vineyard Notes** are available for an additional annual fee of **\$40.00**), Vineyard consultations with FLGP viticulture staff and important announcements about upcoming events, meetings, and reduced workshop fees.
