Mini Romaine Lettuce:
Green to Bronze colored mini lettuce heads known for their compact growth and sweet, crunchy flavor



Sugar Buns Corn
A sugary variety that has the longest harvest life of any early corn.



Butterscotch
Butternut Squash
Sweet, rich flavor on an early maturing fruit that is the perfect dinner size. Store up to 3 months



Pint Size
(Mini Iceberg Lettuce)
Compact mini lettuce heads about 5-6" in size

Cucumber
Tried-and-true standard fresh eating cucumber of the north.



Honeynut Squash
Well loved mini butternut squash. Average weight 1/2-1 1/2 lbs

Includes four different types of leaf-lettuce great for salad mixed



Costata Romanesco
Zucchini
Traditional Italian heirloom with great flavor for fresh or cooked eating .



Sweet Jade
Cute, sea-green squash. Perfect for single servings, soup bowls, with very little waist. Great for singles or small families.



Space Spinach
The tried and true spinach variety for all season harvest slightly savory flavor



Zephyr
Summer Squash
Known to be very delicious , nutty flavor with firm texture



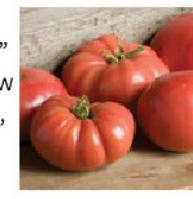
Sunshine Kabocha squash
Smooth, sweet, tender fruit that is excellent for mashing, baking or in pies. avg weight 4-6lbs



Trilogy Mix Beans
A fun mix of green, yellow and purple bush beans



E-Tender Eggplant
Unique "water eggplant" intended to be eaten raw but can be cooked. Soft, slightly sweet, apple like flavor.



German Johnson
Earlier producing Brandywine type tomato. Pink fruit have deep, rich, creamy flavor



Sugar Ann Peas
An exceptionally sweet early maturing dwarf bush pea that produces 2-2.5" peas



Hannah's Choice Melon
Very sweet and full of flavor. Beautiful ribbed fruit. avg weight 3-5lbs



White Cherry
Attractive cherry tomato with mild flavor.



Boro Beets
Good flavor and fast maturing with strong tops. Great winter storage life when stored properly.



Patterson Onion
Exceptionally long storing standard yellow onion.



Sun Gold Cherry Tomato
Sweet, bright orange early tomato with a long harvest season.



Bolero Carrot
Excellent for eating fresh or after long-term storage. Sweet, juicy, complex flavor



Rossa di Milano
A flavorful, very long storing (6+months) red onion that is excellent for cooking.



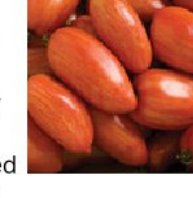
Juliet
Great rich tomato flavor excellent for salads, salsa or fresh pasta sauce. Good crack resistance, vine storage & shelf life



Purple Star Carrot
Early maturing purple carrot. Color darkens with maturity, if harvested young will look tie-died



North Georgia Candy Roaster (Squash)
Hubbard type heirloom that keeps eating quality stored up to 5 months. Great for roasting, stuffed or pie filling. avg. 8-15lbs



Speckled Roman
Bright red plum tomato with golden streaks. Excellent flavor with little juice making it ideal for fresh eating or a quick cooking sauce.
