## HARVEST SHARE SUMMER 2026

Harvest Share brings together the local community and provides valuable work and volunteer opportunities for Schenectady County residents through sustainable agriculture.

### How Harvest Share Works

Shares are distributed every week from June to September. Produce is grown at the Sustainable Living Center with the help of Roots & Wisdom youth participants. Every Monday and Thursday the Sustainable Living Center (SLC) Farm Stand is open from 12:00pm-4:00pm, where Harvest Share members will receive locally grown vegetables, herbs, and flowers based on what is ready for harvest.

Over 100 varieties of produce are grown throughout the season. Options may include tomatoes, eggplants, beets, cucumbers, carrots, radishes, peppers, scallions, summer squashes, leafy greens, herbs, and flowers.

### Benefits of the Program

- Receive high quality, fresh, nutritious produce, grown naturally without conventional chemicals.
- Promote education, job, life-skills, youth development and community service.
- Support a local sustainable food system and preserve the environment.

All proceeds from Harvest Share directly support Roots & Wisdom.
