



2026 4-H Homemade Pie Auction

The 4th annual Niagara County Fair 4-H Pie Auction will be held on Wednesday August 5, at the end of the Farm City Breakfast in the Food Tent Area. Rules & details below.

*****MUST HAVE PARTICIPATED IN AT LEAST ONE 4-H FOODS PIE CLASS IN THE PAST TO ENTER PIE AUCTION*****

- Niagara County enrolled 4-H members ages 8-18, who have participated in at least one of the 4-H Foods Pie Classes in the past, are eligible to participate.
- Only non-perishable pies may be entered (no pumpkin, cream, chocolate, etc.)
- 8"-10" diameter pies must be baked in a disposable pie plate at their home.
- Pastry and filling must be homemade, no convenience foods.
- All pies should have a top and bottom crust. (Lattice is acceptable)
- Pies should be covered when delivered to the Niagara County Fair.
- Line up your bidders. Encourage people to buy your pie!
- **NEW!** Pie bakers receive 80% of sales and the 4-H Foods Program will receive 20%.

Wednesday, August 5, at the Niagara County Fair:

- Bring covered pie to the Food Tent Area by 7:30am to register. (Enter at Gate #1; Breakfast starts at 8am)
- Pie boxes will be provided for the pies.
- All pies will be displayed near the Food Tent (by Farm City Breakfast) for public viewing.
- The member will present the pie to the public. (Wear appropriate attire, hats and aprons are acceptable)
- Members may showcase their pie among the audience to encourage people to bid.
- Pies will be numbered to be sold. Name, age and flavor of pie will be announced.
- Bidders will be recognized by the volunteer auctioneers.
- After payment, the buyer takes ownership of the pie. (It can be stored for the owner.)
