MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

Month	To do
March	Start seeds indoors
April	Start seeds indoors Clean up winter debris Test soil pH, add compost and/or other soil amendments Plant early cool-weather crops
May	Plant warm-season vegetables around Memorial Day Mulch bed to keep weeds down and to retain moisture Harvest early, cool-weather crops
June	Continue planting (succession plant) Water regularly (about 1 inch per week) Harvest early, cool-weather crops Weeding
July	Monitor for pests & diseases Fertilize (heavy feeders such as tomatoes) Weed and harvest regularly
August	Direct sow fall vegetables Water deeply during hot spells Weed and harvest regularly. If applicable, plant cover crop.
September	Harvest remaining summer crops. If applicable, plant cover crop. Harvest fall crops Weeding
October	Harvest remaining fall crops Remove dead foliage & plants Apply a layer of mulch after the ground freezes or plant cover crop.
Winter	Clean tools Turn off irrigation systems Review & reflect, order seeds and plan for next season
