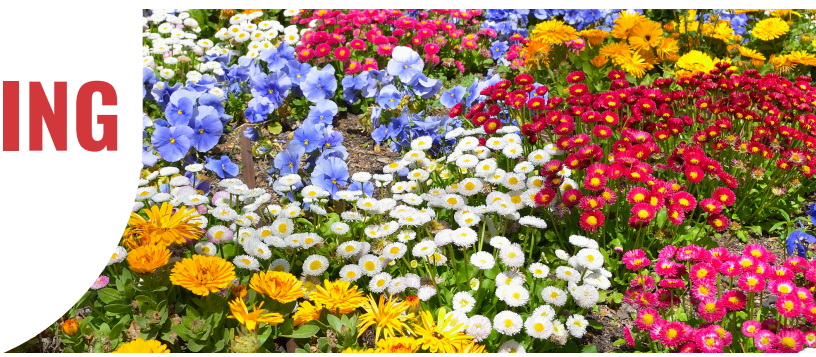


INTERESTED IN BECOMING A HORTICULTURE VOLUNTEER?
