Sullivan County 4-H Livestock & Ag Product Auction Commitment Form

1. Youth must be enrolled in Sullivan County 4-H by June 1st.
2. All auction entries must be submitted by June 1st.
3. Youth may only enter 3 products and 1 animal from 2 different species.
4. Youth must complete and submit a record book upon completion of the project. Due by September 15th.
5. Animals must have a clean bill of health at time of auction.
6. Animals must meet the minimum and maximum weight requirements.
7. All male animals must be fully castrated.
8. All 4-H members who are participating in the auction are required to attend one auction meeting.
9. All 4-H youth must complete YQCA training and submit certification to 4-H office by July 1st.
10. All animals and products must be exhibited at the fair.
11. Ag Products must receive a blue Danish ribbon in order to be sold.
12. Exhibitors are responsible for representing their animal/product in the sale ring.
13. Youth must write letters to 5 potential buyers. It is recommended that youth should follow up with in person visits to their potential buyers. Names of buyers and addresses must be submitted to the 4-H office.
14. Youth must write a thank you note to all buyers of their animal/product, they will not receive their check until they submit a copy to the 4-H office.
15. Youth are required to meet all deadlines and requirements.
16. Proceeds from the first sale of animal/product will be 85% to the youth and 15% to the scholarship fund. Any item donated back, proceeds will go 100% to the scholarship or education fund.
