PRODUCTION CLASSES

Any Breed or Variety: These birds will be judged on health, vigor and egg production characteristics. Bantam entries are allowed.

Hen – should be in active production

Pullet – egg-production type breeds under 1 year

Trio – One male and two females from egg production flock. Each trio should be of the same size/age/type.

Hen/ Pullet Pet- not of pure breed/variety

Cock- over 1 year

Cockerel- under 1 year

Cock/ Cockerel Pet- not of pure breed/variety

Meat Production Classes

Fryers—8-12 weeks.

Roasters—12-20 weeks.

Capons, Caponettes—12 weeks to 6 months.

Fowl over 20 weeks
