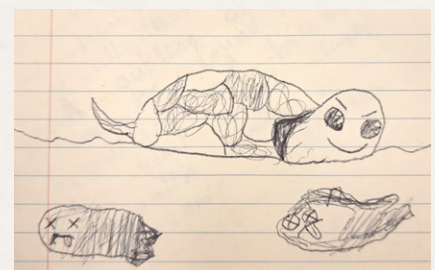
RECHARGE

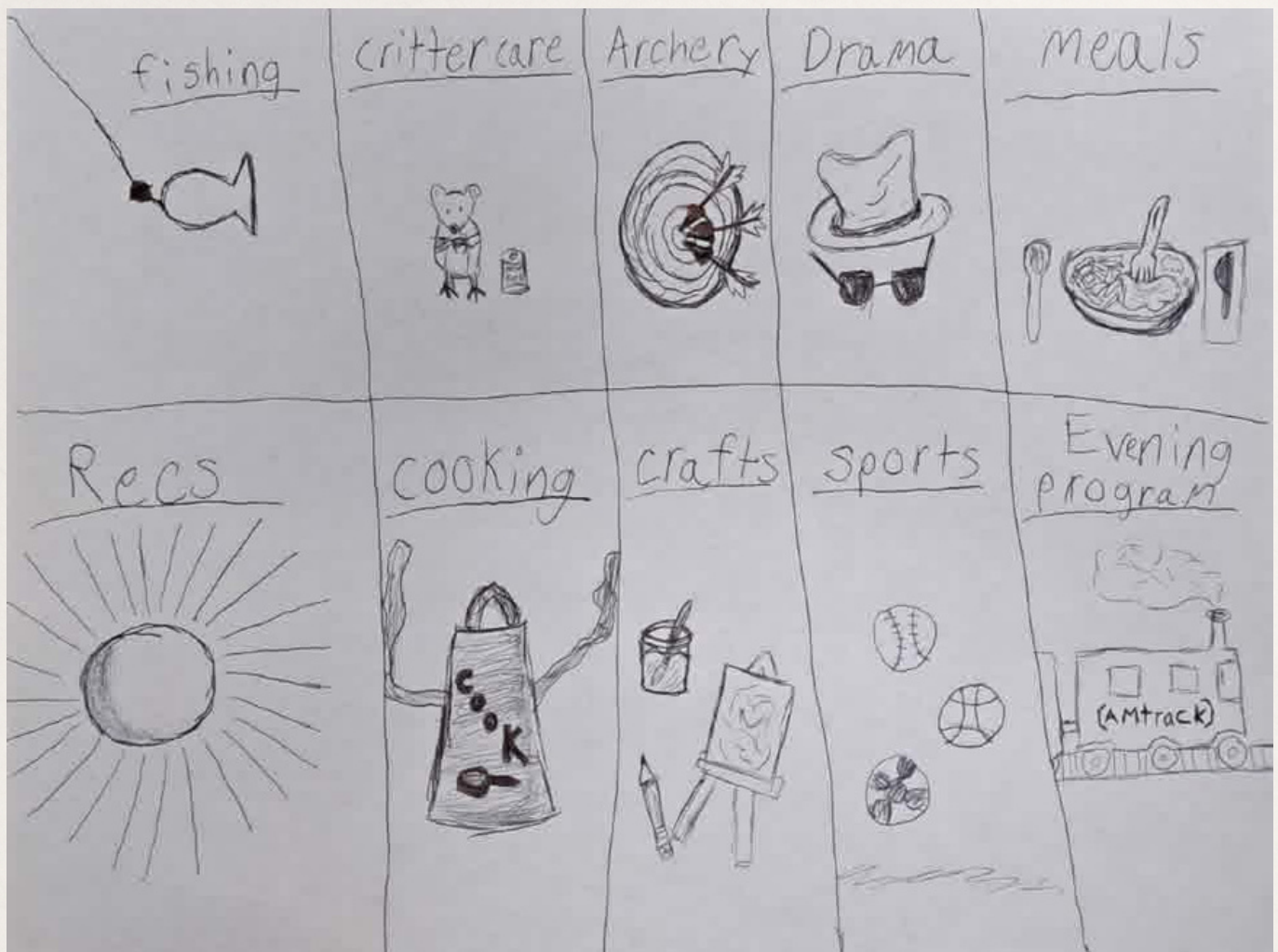
SPORTS

Chipper loves kickball. She's been a counselor for 2 summers, and has been coming to camp for 12! She loves counseling North Star and Lakeside.

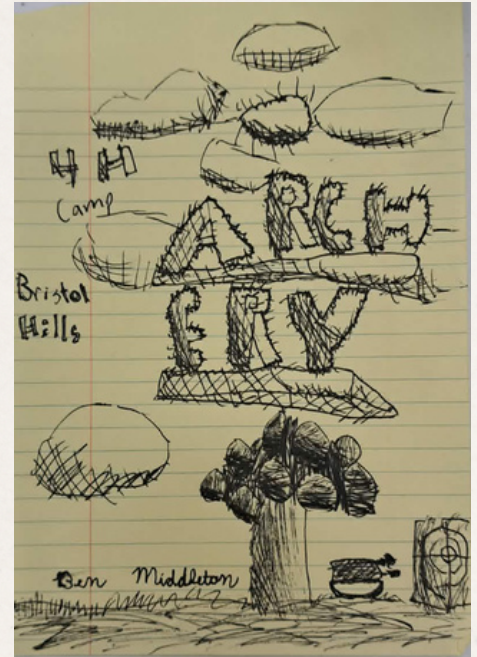
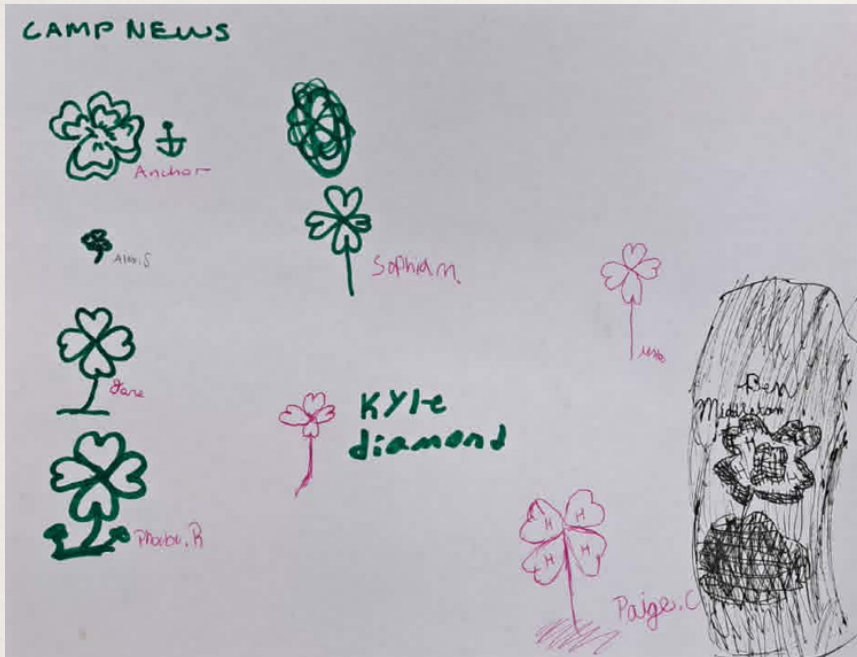
