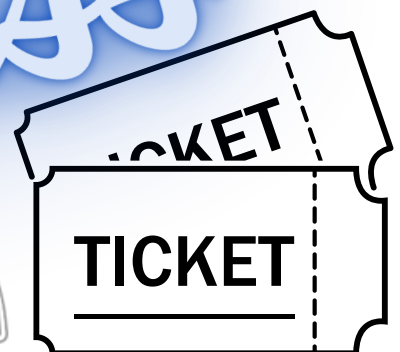

How does my participation help?

Buyer participation helps 4-H'ers complete his or her animal project by providing a viable market for each participant's project animal. Profits from the project(s) are often re-invested in other project animals and/or saved for schooling.

Why do I want to participate?

This is a great opportunity to show support for our local youth and agriculture, while also filling your freezer with lean wholesome meat. You also receive a tax deduction and free advertising as a buyer.

Ways to Participate

- Attend the auction, register at the trailer and get a bidding #, bid on the animal of your choice.
- Have a friend or family member bid/purchase an animal for you if you cannot attend.
- Split costs with friends or family members and share the product.
- Call the 4-H office prior to auction if you would prefer to bid live over the phone

What if I am a successful bidder?

- Report to the auction clerk (trailer) to indicate whether you would like the animal processed, kept for personal use, resold, or donated back to the 4-H program.
 - Decide which processor you would like to use.
- Pay for the purchase by cash, check or credit card
 - 4-H Member will arrange transportation of your purchased animal to the processor

Approximate Amount of Meat the Buyer Receives

Beef - 1,200 lb live steer will yield about 490 lbs packaged meat.

Hogs - 250 lb live market hog will yield about 133 lbs packaged meat.

Lambs - 120 lb live market lamb will yield about 49 lbs packaged meat.

Goats - 80 lb live market goat will yield about 33 lbs of packaged meat.

Meat Rabbits - 10-15 lbs. of meat per pair

Meat Birds - 12-22 lbs. of chicken per pair

All examples are for bone-in, closely trimmed products. Processing preferences will affect the amount of meat produced.
