Join us in visiting with Peachey Farm, Citadel Ranch, and Wagner Vineyards Estate Winery and the related Seneca County agricultural and conservation agencies that support them.

To create a greater understanding of practices occurring in today's agriculture, three agricultural operations in Seneca County are inviting the public to learn more about how farms are striving to remain profitable while being compatible with the environment and aid in efforts that benefit water quality.

The host farms are **Peachey Farm, Citadel Ranch, and Wagner Vineyards**. The tour topics will feature growing mushrooms commercially, prescribed rotational grazing and manure management, erosion control in vineyards, and a discussion about the costs associated with implementing water quality practices.

The tour concludes with a glass of wine or beer, appetizers, and dinner at The Ginny Lee Café at Wagner Vineyards Estate Winery.

Host farms will be joined by Cornell Cooperative Extension specialists from the NWN Y Dairy, Livestock & Field Crops Team, Finger Lakes Grape Program, Cornell Vegetable Program, Seneca County Soil & Water Conservation District, and Seneca Lake Pure Waters Association, as well as other agriculture industry related professionals.
