After 275 votes were cast, the winner had a clear 42.9% of the vote.

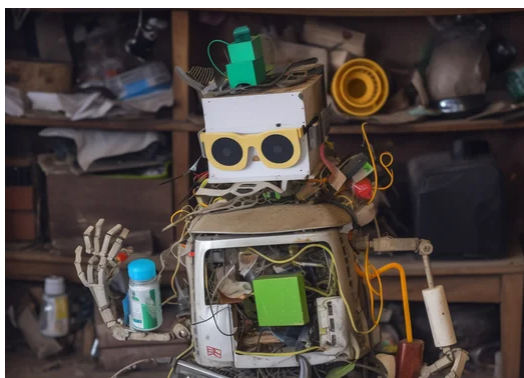
Congratulations to **Cici M. with Star Spangled Swirl!**
