

Helen Fleming Stone NAHS Scholarship Participation Agreement

Each year the family of Dr. Helen Fleming Stone presents a scholarship to a Georgia NAHS member. The Georgia Art Education Association administers the scholarship competition following the instructions that Dr. Stone provided when she established the scholarship.

There are specific requirements to be completed by the Helen Fleming Stone NAHS scholarship winner before the scholarship check can be awarded. **Please read these guidelines carefully and be aware that they must be followed exactly.**

The scholarship winner must

1. Attend the Helen Fleming Stone Reception during the Georgia Art Education Fall Conference. The next fall conference will take place November 13-15, 2026 in Young Harris, GA
2. be enrolled in or have completed at least one visual art course at a college or university at the time of the GAEA Fall Conference at which the scholarship check is to be presented. A letter from the university registrar, a copy of the student's course schedule, or a grade transcript may be submitted as proof of enrollment.
3. write two thank you letters for the scholarship, one to the Georgia Art Education Association and one to the Stone family.

The materials listed in #2 and #3 above, along with an acknowledgement that the student will attend the fall conference scholarship reception must be sent to the GAEA Stone Scholarship Liaison no later than **September 15, 2026**. The current liaison is

The scholarship winner must be prepared to travel to the Georgia Art Education Association Fall Conference at his or her own expense. The student must be present at the reception during the fall conference in order to receive the scholarship check. **If you have committed to attend a school that is a long distance away and feel that returning to Georgia for the fall conference would place too great a hardship on you, it would be unwise for you to enter this scholarship competition.**

If you cannot complete the requirements listed above, the scholarship will be awarded to the student who is the second place finalist. If the second place finalist cannot meet all of the requirements, then the award will be presented to the third place finalist, provided that he or she meets all the criteria.
