- Jacob's Favorite: Coat of Many Colors
- **■** Taken as Slave to Egypt
- Fled from Temptation—thrown in jail
- Interpreted Pharaoh's Dreams
- Rose to Second in Command
- 10 Genesis-The Time of the Patriarchs
  - Joseph predicted famine
  - His family came from Canaan & saved
  - Forgave his brothers
    - "You intended it for evil,
    - but God intended it for good."




