Not one of them is missing.



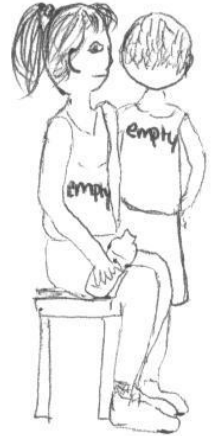

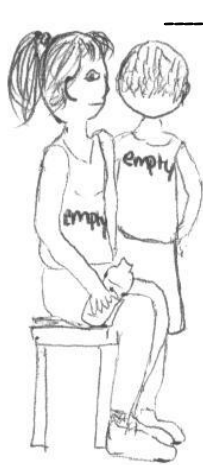

Start at CrossWalk ~ Follow-up at home

Make extra copies of the verses and take Moses' advice in Deuteronomy 6:6-9...

"...teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand and they shall be as frontals on your forehead. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."

- ✓ Put copies **in places the kids will see them often**— kitchen table (under a clear placemat?), in the car, bed headboard, on the mirror.
- ✓ Establish a **regular time to practice** —Summertime still has its routines... 1st thing in the morning or last thing at night, while brushing teeth, before TV or computer goes on!
- ✓ **Read the passage once a day** - to get the heart & mind dwelling on God's Word.

- ✓ **Come alongside** - Learn & memorize together with your child. You'll be blessed, too!!

If memorizing Bible verses is a new skill, or a major challenge, help your child **set personal mini-goals** of shorter portions of CrossWalk passages. Add your own rewards that you know are especially motivating for your child. At your child's pace, build up to learning entire passages.
