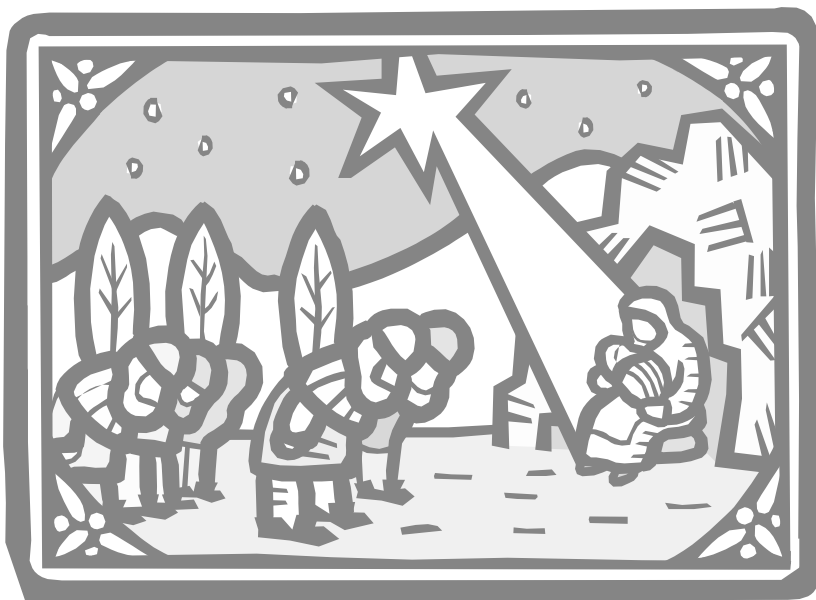

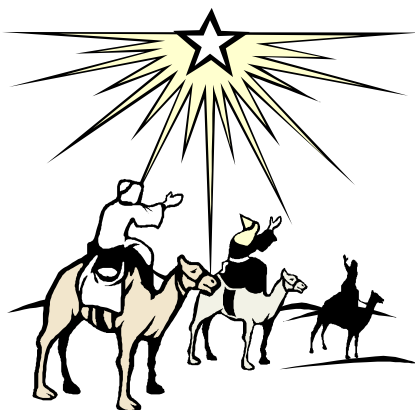

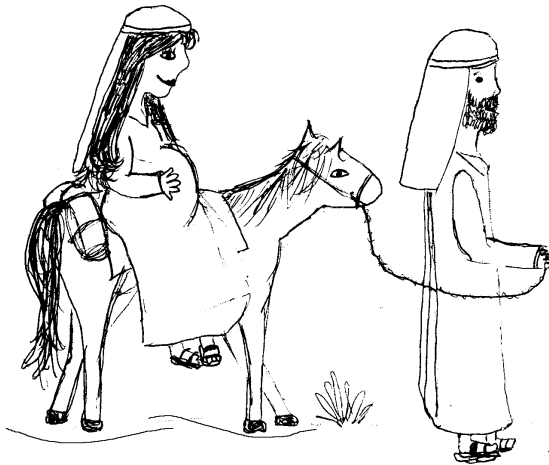
Luke 2:1, 4-14

with whom He is pleased."

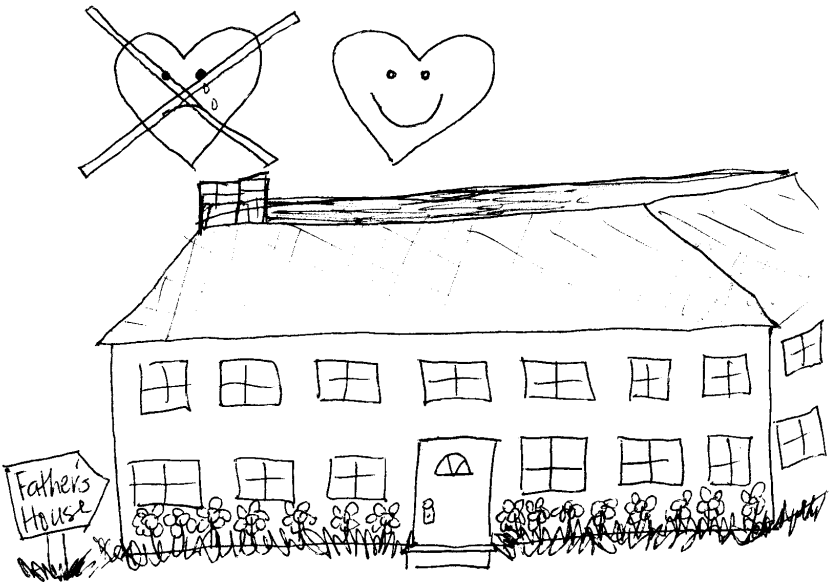

John 14: 1-6

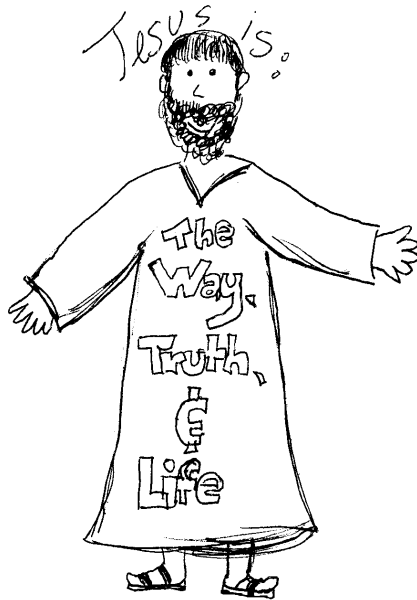
_____ 4 "And you know the way where I am going."

the name which is above every name,



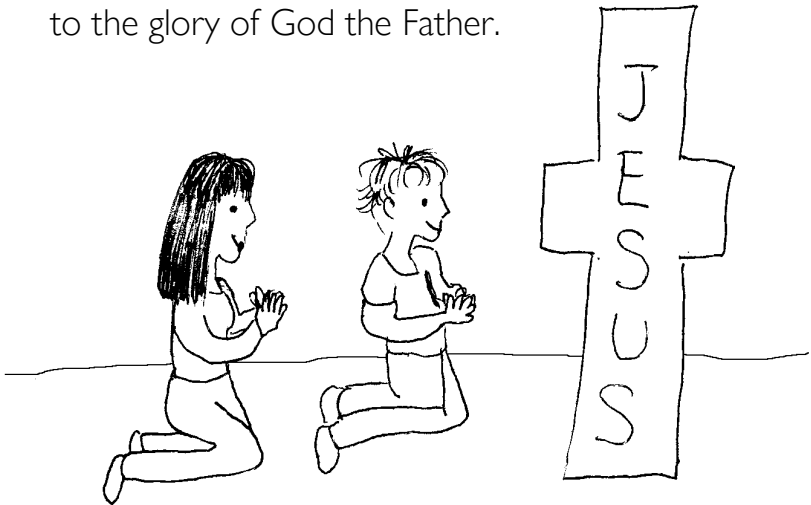

to the glory of God the Father.

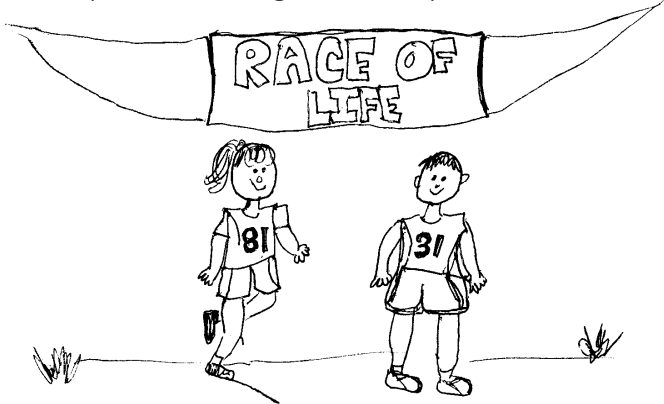


LOOKING AT JESUS

Run the Race Well!

Hebrews 12: 1-6

- _____ 1 Therefore, since we have
so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us,
let us also lay aside every encumbrance
and the sin which so easily entangles us,
and let us run with endurance
the race that is set before us,
- _____ 2 fixing our eyes on Jesus,
the author and perfecter of faith,
who for the joy set before Him endured the cross,
despising the shame, and has sat down
at the right hand of the throne of God.
- _____ 3 For consider Him who has endured
such hostility by sinners against Himself,
so that you will not grow weary and lose heart.

Start at the CrossWalk, follow-up at home

- ☆ Teach your kids to **keep track of their CrossWalk booklets** and encourage them to **practice at home**.
- ☆ Print extra copies from our chapel website <https://www.hillviewbiblechapel.org/crosswalk> and **display verses where kids will see them** often – kitchen table, bedroom wall, car, bathroom mirror, etc.
- ☆ Establish a **regular time to practice EVERY day** – FIRST thing in the morning AND last thing at night, on the way to school or soccer practice, *before* turning on video game or tv, etc.
- ☆ **Encourage your child!** Make practicing verses fun & positive. Add your own rewards* at home. You know best what motivates your child!
- ☆ **Memorize together!** Learn the passages along with your child. Competition is good for your older brain, and such an encouragement to your child! **Help your child look up verses in their Bible. Tell what God's Word means to each of you.** Chant or sing verses together!
- ☆ If memorizing Bible verses is a new skill or **a major challenge**, help your child **set a personal goal** of part of an assignment. Encourage him/her to earn your rewards* for smaller parts of a CrossWalk Passage a time. Eventually build up to learn entire assignments & passages.
