Welcome to Summer CrossWalk!

Summer means lots of free time in the **sun**. It's perfect for spending time with the **SON** of God -- Jesus! Learning Bible verses about Jesus is like spending time with Him!



Jesus was once a kid like you, too, playing with friends & going to school. But Jesus obeyed God all the time because God is His Father and He loves God.

When you or I disobey God, even once, we sin. Our sin keeps us out of God's family. But Jesus **LOVES** you! He wants to be your Friend! He wants you to join Him in God's family!

So, when Jesus grew up, He died to remove your sin. **THEN**, He came back to life, so you could also live forever in God's family with Him!

Do you want to have Jesus as your Friend who takes away your sins? If you **admit** you're truly sorry for disobeying God, & **believe** Jesus died to pay for your sin, & came back alive. Then, you'll be free from your sin & can join God's family forever!

and the glory forever. Amen.'"



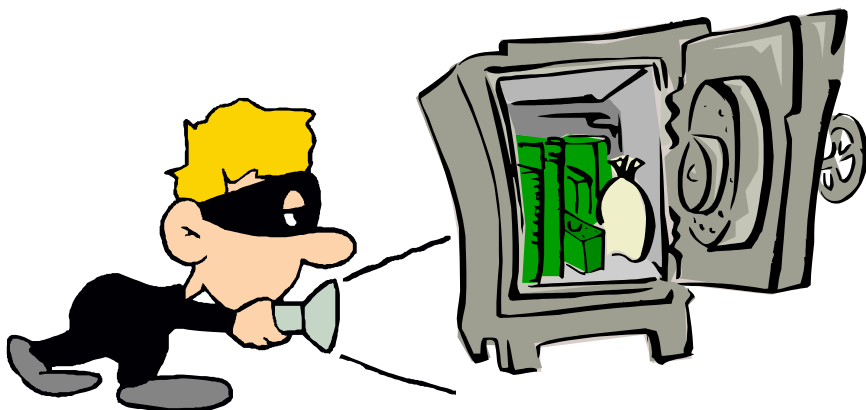

- ☆ **Put them in places kids will see them often!**

--- at the kitchen table, in the car, on the bed
headboard, bathroom mirror, etc.
