____ ² this man came to Jesus by night and said to Him, "Rabbi, we know that You have come from God as a teacher; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with him."

____ ³ Jesus answered and said to him, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God."

____ ⁴ Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? He cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born, can he?"

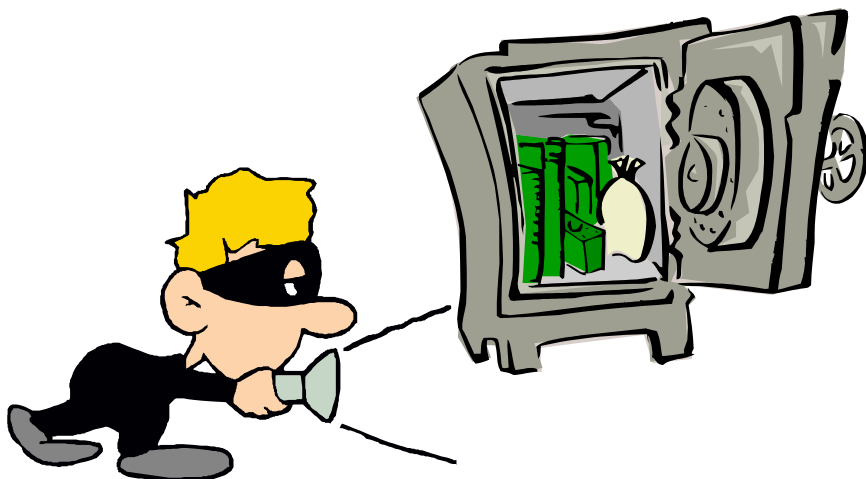
Don't Worry, Be Happy—in Christ!

Are you not worth much more than they?

_____ ³⁰ “But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, will He not much more clothe you? You of little faith!”

HOW DOES CROSSWALK WORK?

--- at the kitchen table, in the car, on the bed
headboard, bathroom mirror, etc.
