THE PLAN

Two-year cycle of Bible passages

CrossWalk is our Bible memorization program for kids in grades K-5. It includes Bible passages on topics that are foundational to the Christian life, eg. God, salvation & living with Jesus, etc. We teach *passages* of longer portions of scripture to give kids more context & meaning from God's Word as they memorize.

We teach 32 passages over a 2-year cycle. 15 passages in the first year, 17 more passages in the second year. Then, we repeat the cycle with most kids having advanced 2 grades to the next CrossWalk level.

We divided each passage into age-appropriate segments, the older the child, the longer the passage. As kids go from K through to 5th grade, they review each passage a total of 3 times. Every two years, they learn more segments of these same passages.

Example: All grades will learn Psalm 1:

- K-1st grade kids learn verses 1 & 2
- 2nd-3rd graders review verses 1 & 2, + learn verse 3
- 4th-5th graders review verses 1-3, + learn verses 4-6

This progression fits reasonably well with most kids' budding reading abilities. Repeated review of learned segments aids in success & long-term retention. Adding longer segments to the same passages in each cycle provides challenge & depth to avert boredom. By 5th grade, kids can memorize 244 verses of the Bible!

We pray this cumulative immersion in God's Word may help lead each child to their salvation and a healthy relationship with God, through Jesus!

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Start at CrossWalk, follow-up at home

Teaching/learning verses:

On Sundays at CrossWalk, we teach Bible Passages through fun games & activities. Typically, we work on a given passage for **2-4 weeks**. Depending on the passage length & grade level, we add 1-3 verses/week.

Grades K-1: ~ 1 verse per week

Grades 2-3: ~ 2 verses per week

Grades 4-5: ~ 3 verses per week

Reciting verses for rewards:

Also on Sundays, kids can recite verses to their CrossWalk leaders for prizes! *Please help kids **keep track of CrossWalk books to practice at home & bring on Sundays to get signed off for PRIZES!***

THE BATTLE STARTS NOW!

More than prizes, the real reward of receiving God's Word is salvation! Teaching kids Bible verses is a first step to implanting it in their hearts. (James 1:21)

It's easy for kids to get too busy to learn the Bible. Parents must **help set high standards! Don't allow distractions** from learning God's Word.

Take full advantage of CrossWalk to help your child form these habits early! Ultimately, **pray for your child's salvation** as the fruit of knowing and believing the gospel of His Word!

GUIDELINES TO GET YOU MOVIN' !

1. **Recite the heading for each passage.**
"God's Glory" is the heading for Passage 1 in this book.
2. **Recite the Bible reference.** Eg. "Psalm 19:1-2,7-11,14"
3. **Recite the verses exactly as they appear in the Bible*.** Do not add, do not change or leave out any words. *We use the NASB® 1995 Bible version.

M.O.V.E. – Meditate On a Verse Everyday!

1. **Ask God to help you!** You're on a great adventure to find treasure! (Psalm 19:72, 127)
2. **Start memorizing on MONDAY!** Start with the 1st verse. **Every day**, review it & add a new verse. Learn passages to remember them for the rest of your life!! (Psalm 119:14-16, 97)
3. **Listen for God to speak to your heart through His Word!** Pray that He will help you understand His message to you. (Psalm 119:11, 34)
4. **Read the passages in your Bible once a day!** This can help you learn it even if you don't have time to practice memorizing.
5. **Practice your passages on the move at:**

6. **Ask a friend or family member to quiz you!**
