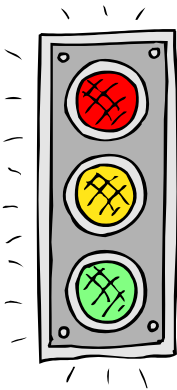

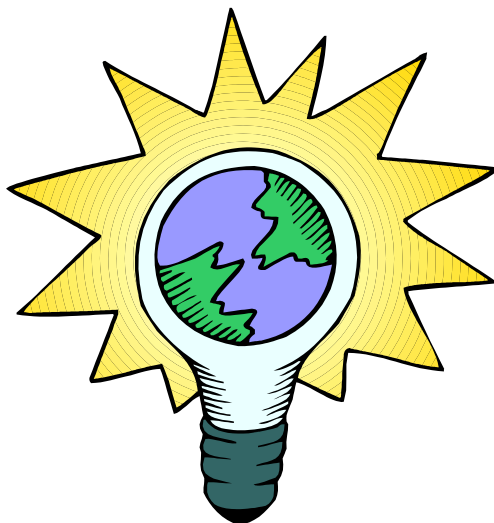
PASSAGE ONE

even to those who believe in His name,



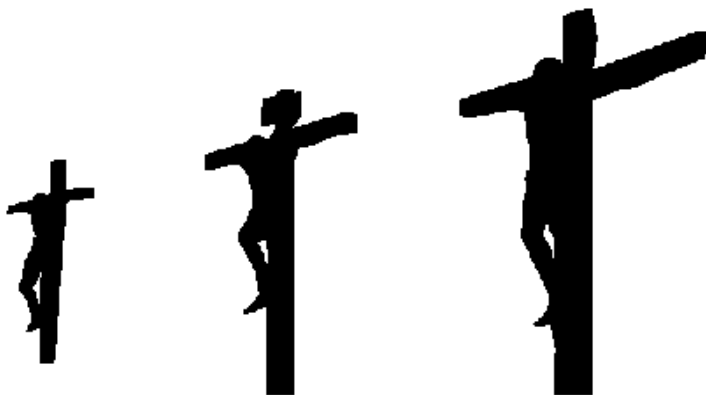

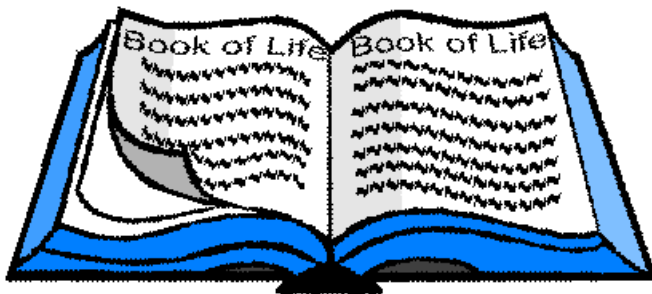

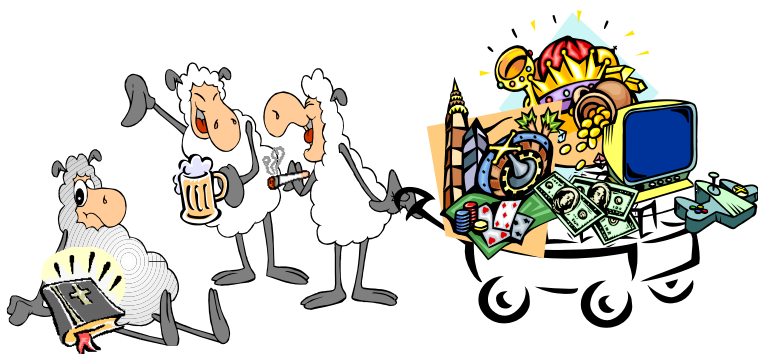
God's Patience and Soon Return

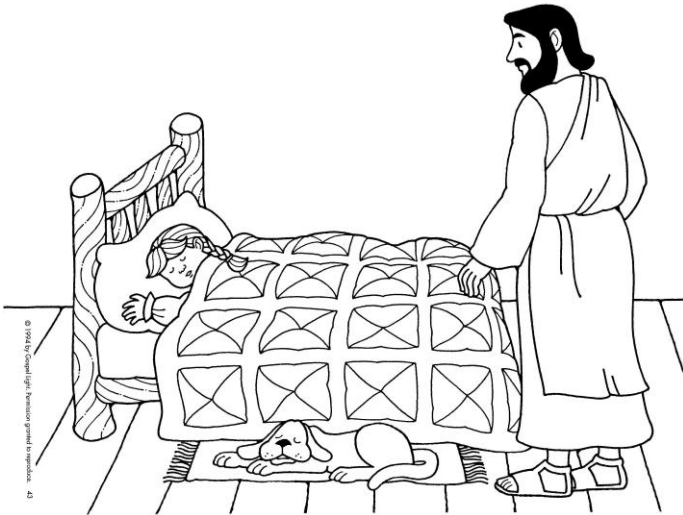

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Start at the CrossWalk, follow-up at home

Sundays – CrossWalk will get kids *started* on memorizing Bible Passages in the NASB® 1995 version.

Monday-Saturday – *Parents please* help your child:

- **PRACTICE** the passages
- BRING his/her **CrossWalk book each Sunday**
- **Make extra copies of the verses** from www.hillviewbiblechapel.org/crosswalk and take Moses' advice in Deut 6:7-9...

"You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand and they shall be as frontals on your forehead. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."

- ☆ **Put verses where kids see them often**
kitchen table (under a clear placemat?), on your fridge, in the car, on a bathroom or bedroom mirror.
- ☆ **Set a regular time to practice** –
Summertime still has routines... 1st thing in the morning or last thing at night, at breakfast, while brushing teeth, before TV or computer goes on!
- ☆ **Read & practice saying the passage once EVERY day** to help get their hearts and minds dwelling on God's Word as a daily habit

Guidelines to get you Movin'!

1. Memorize the heading with each assignment.
2. Memorize the Bible references.



3. Memorize the verses exactly as they appear in the Bible (we recommend NASB version). Do not add, do not change and do not leave out any words.
4. Recite an entire assignment at one time to get it signed off by a leader.

Be diligent and aim for excellence!

Try your best to get every word correct!

It's good training and worthwhile!
