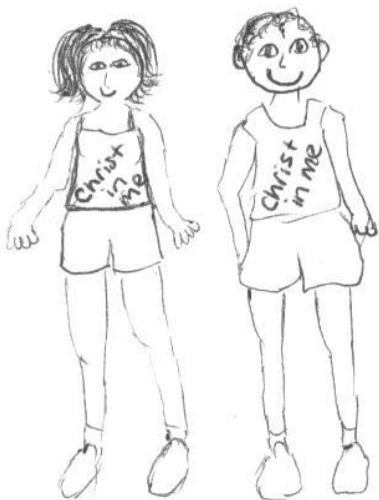

Not one *of them* is missing.

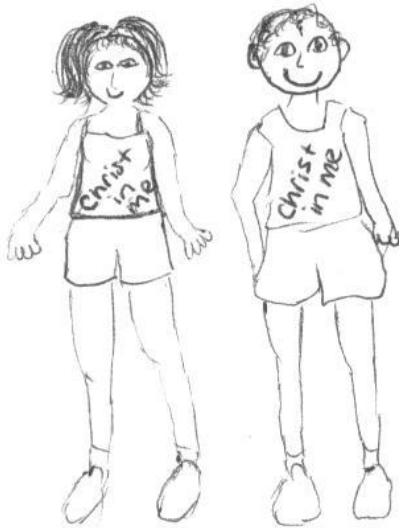

His understanding is inscrutable.

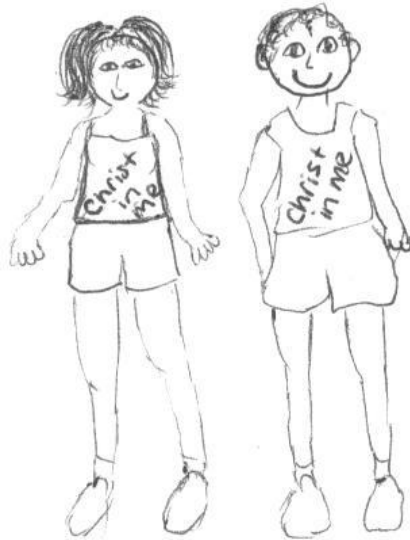


GOD & ME

Start at CrossWalk, follow-up at home

Make extra copies of the verses & follow Deuteronomy 6:6-9...

"You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand and they shall be as frontals on your forehead. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."

Put them in places your kids will see them often...

- at your kitchen table (under a clear placemat?), in the car, bed headboard, on the bathroom or bedroom mirror

Establish a regular time to practice

Summertime still has its routines...

Practice 1st thing in the morning or last thing at night, at breakfast, or *before* TV or computer goes on!

Just **reading the passage once a day** also helps get their hearts and minds dwelling on God's Word.
