

Luke 22:14-20

v.15 And He said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer;

v.16 for I say to you, I shall never again eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God."

v.17 And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He said, "Take this and share it among yourselves;

v.18 for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine from now on until the kingdom of God comes."

1 Cor 11:23 "For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus in the night in which He was betrayed took bread;"





1Cor. 11:27 *Therefore whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an **unworthy manner**, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of the Lord.*

- Important for the sake of the other ministries
 - To consider:
 - Keep the in between sharing to a minimum
 - Pray for the bread and the cup when you share close to passing the emblems
 - If you were to choose a song when the offering is passed, choose one that is short or select a limited number of verses
 - Don't start sharing until the ushers have settled down



Participate – Don'ts

1. Don't preach a sermon
2. Don't feel you have to be profound
3. Don't feel you need to have a devotion + prayer + hymn
4. Don't feel intimidated by someone with more experience than you
5. Avoid setting patterns for yourself
6. Don't pick a song while the emblems are passed; some may want to remember the Lord in quietness

8. Don't worry about doing things wrong or saying things wrong




