"THILIPSIS"

Thilipsis — "a pressing pressure, anything which burdens the spirit, distress"

Rev 2:9, "I know your tribulation (thilipsis)..."

John 16:33, "These things I have spoken to you, so that in Me you may have peace. In the world you have tribulation (thilipsis), but take courage; I have overcome the world."

Matt. 7:14 "For the gate is small and the way is narrow (Thilibo) that leads to life, and there are few who find it."

If gospel is the message and Christlikeness is the goal, then "Thilipsis" (tribulation) is inevitable
