4:1-16

Children vs. Sons

- **♦** Immature
- Need guardians / managers vs 2
- Enslaved to weak,elemental things vs 3,8
- Why be enslaved all over again to weak, worthless, elemental things? Vs 9-11

- Adopted as a mature son & heir vs 5
- Redeemed/freed from under the law vs 5
- Spirit indweltbelievers who can callout "Abba! Father!"vs 6
- ♦ No longer a slave vs 7



Galatians 4:4 "But when the fulness of the time came, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the Law."

Walvrood: "This 'time' was when the Roman civilization had brought peace and a road system which facilitated travel; when the Grecian civilization provided a language which was adopted as the lingua franca of the empire; when the Jews had proclaimed monotheism and the messianic hope in the synagogues of the Mediterranean world. It was then that God sent His Son, the preexistent One, out of heaven and to earth on a mission."



4:17-5:1

Bondage vs. Freedom

- False teachers eagerly seek you, but with wrong motives. Vs 17
- Paul wanting to seeChrist formed in them.Vs 19

Col. 1:28 "And we proclaim Him, admonishing every man and teaching every man with all wisdom, that we may present every man complete in Christ."



4:17-5:1

Bondage vs. Freedom

- ♦ Hagar vs 22-25
- ♦ Ishmael, a picture of the flesh vs 23
- Mt Sinai/ earthlyJerusalem vs 24,25
- **♦** Enslaved
- Persecutes those born of the Spirit vs 29
- Cast out the bondwoman & son vs 30

- ♦ Sarah vs 22-25
- Isaac, a picture of God's promise.vs 28
- ♦ Jerusalem above
- ♦ Free vs 26
- Persecuted

Law & Grace can't be mixed



5:2-15 Justification by:

Legalism

- Christ will be of no benefit
- Obligated to keep the whole law vs 3

vs 2

- Severed from Christ vs 4
- Hindrance to the truth vs 7
- ♦ Not from Christ vs 8
- ♦ Likened to leaven vs 9
- Legalism brings judgment vs 10
- ♦ Let the troublemakers mutilate themselves vs 12
- Legalism leads to quarrels vs 15

Grace VS.

- Christ has set us free vs 1
- Faith waits for the hope of righteousness vs 5
- Faith works through love vs 6
- ♦ The Cross is a stumbling block to man's pride. vs 11
- ♦ Christian liberty is not a license to sin vs 13
- ♦ Liberty serves out of love vs 13,14



5:16-24

Flesh vs. Spirit

- Sets its desires against the Spirit. Vs 17
- Deeds of the flesh:
 Immorality, impurity,
 sensuality, idolatry,
 sorcery, enmities, strife,
 jealousy, anger, disputes,
 dissensions, factions,
 envying, drunkeness,
 carousing. Vs 19-21
- ♦ Those who practice these will not inherit the Kingdom of God. Vs 21

- Walk by the Spirit not the flesh. vs 16
- ♦ If led by the Spirit, you're not under the Law. Vs 18
- ♦ The Fruit of the Spirit:
 Love, joy, peace,
 patience, kindness,
 goodness, faithfulness,
 gentleness, self-control;
 vs 22-23



5:25-6:10 Practical Exhortations

- Walk in the Spirit 5:25
- ♦ Don't be boastful 5:26
- Gently restore those caught in sin 6:1
- Bear one another's burdens 6:2
- Examine yourself rather than compare yourself w/ others 6:4

- ♦ Each of us needs to bear our own load of responsibility. 6:5
- Support godly teachers6:6
- ♦ Remember we reap what we sow 6:7-9
- Do good to all, especially to other believers 6:10



6:11-18 Conclusion

- ♦ See Paul's LARGE LETTERS! vs 11
- ♦ Beware of those wanting to make a good showing in the flesh. vs 12
- ♦ Legalists are not as interested in keeping the law as in gaining a long list of followers. v 13
- ♦ Boast not in the flesh but in Christ crucified. vs 14
- ♦ What really matters is being a new creature in Christ, not circumcision. vs 15, 2Cor. 5:17
- ◆ Paul gives a blessing of peace & mercy on the new creation & the 'Israel of God.' vs 16
- ♦ "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brethren. Amen." Vs 18
