Toronto, ON - Hot Docs is excited to announce the return of popular and long-running series *Doc Soup*, as well as the addition of several documentaries to the *Must-See Docs* lineup at Hot Docs Cinema, and a new Halloween-themed series that will bring iconic horror titles to the cinema this fall. In advance of November's Curious Minds Festival, Hot Docs Cinema will welcome author Ronald J. Deibert to discuss and read from his latest novel, *Chasing Shadows*, as part of the *Curious Minds Author Talks* series.

Doc Soup returns for the 2025-26 season with monthly screenings at Hot Docs Cinema. The series will launch on October 8 with a screening of festival circuit favourite *The Librarians* (D: Kim A Snyder | USA | 92 minutes | 2025). Set against the chilling backdrop of censorship efforts in multiple US states, this Sundance hit introduces and celebrates the vital, everyday heroes who are fighting back and defending intellectual freedom. The Doc Soup event includes a post-screening Q&A with award-winning director Kim A Snyder. This year's Doc Soup season will include seven monthly screenings from October to April. The ghosts of the Bloor Cinema rise again with the Halloween series *Nightmares on Bloor Street*, a chilling selection of classics and genre-benders aimed at getting audiences good and goosepimply for spooky season. On the heels of Curious Minds Festival taking place later the same month, *Curious Minds Author Talks* return in November with author Ronald J. Deibert live on stage to discuss his latest novel, *Chasing Shadows*. In this real-life spy thriller, cyber security expert Ronald Deibert uncovers the unseemly marketplace for high-tech surveillance, professional disinformation, and computerized malfeasance. He reveals how his team of digital sleuths at the Citizen Lab have lifted the lid on dozens of covert operations targeting innocent citizens everywhere.

Joining the films and events above is concert film *GHOST: Rite Here Rite Now* (D: Alex Ross Perry, Tobias Forge | USA | 139 minutes | 2024). Shot during Ghost's sold out two-night finale of their Re-Imperatour tour at Los Angeles' Kia Forum, *GHOST: Rite Here Rite Now* immerses viewers in the Grammy-winning theatrical rock band's debut film, blending live performance with a narrative story that will leave audiences completely spellbound in the thrall of this bombastic yet intimate cinematic portrait of Ghost.

A historic, century-old landmark located in Toronto's vibrant Annex neighbourhood, the Cinema is a year-round home for non-fiction film and storytelling, presenting first-run international and Canadian documentaries, curated film and speakers series, signature events including Hot Docs Canadian International Documentary Festival, Hot Docs Podcast Festival and Curious Minds Weekend, as well as hosting for some of the city's premier festivals and events. Since assuming management in 2012, Hot Docs has screened over 1,425 films to audiences of more than 1.3 million. In 2016, a generous \$5-million donation from Rogers Foundation enabled Hot Docs to purchase the venue.
