

Wynnum Golf Club Regulations - COVID-19 restricted trading period

25th March 2020

These rules have been set for us to meet our legal obligations, and more importantly protecting the health and wellbeing of our members and the community. The focus of these regulations is to minimise the risk of transmission both controlling the movement of people at the venue which will minimise the risk that members will come into close contact with each other.

It is a condition of entry to the course that all members have read and agree to abide by these regulations.


General conditions

- Federal and Government Social Distancing requirements apply at all times including, but not confined to:
 - Stand 2 meters apart at any time – be particularly vigilant with this around high risk areas (tees and greens)
 - No physical contact permitted.
 - If you have any cold or flu like symptoms or a temperature, do not come to the club.
- Play is available to members only, no visitors or guests.
- Competitions will be single tee start only to minimise traffic through the pro-shop before play.
- If you do not want to play in the competition, you can still book in the competition field and play socially (except Saturdays).
- Play will only be permitted with a booking (competition and social).
- Tee times will in 10 minute intervals.
- Competitions will be run at the following times from Saturday 28th March (Thursday 26th and Friday 27th will commence at normal times with 10 minute spacings (check the timesheet before arriving):
 - Sat – 6.30am to 1.00pm.
 - All other days will be 7.30am to 1.00pm.
 - No tee times (social or competition) will be available after 1.00pm.
- Arrive for your round 15 minutes prior to your tee time. With the introduction of 10 minute intervals, this ensures there are only 16 golfers at any time around the clubhouse and pro-shop at any one time (arrivals, players on the 1st tee and players completing 9th and 18th). **Important** - We acknowledge that this will limit our Saturday fields, so we ask those who play multiple times per week or can play their weekly round on another day to do so to allow those that can only play on Saturday the opportunity.
- Leave the club immediately after your round – do not linger.
- Water fountains will be turned off, it is essential that you bring your own water.
- Motorised Carts (bookings essential) - 1 member and golf bag per cart (including owned/private carts). A reduced fee of \$20 will apply.
- No food or alcohol will be served.

- No BYO alcohol is permitted on the entire premises.
- No nearest to pins or longest drives will be in place
- Social distancing requirements apply to practice areas (figures include staff and teaching professionals):
 - No more than 5 individuals on the practice green (one per hole) while maintaining 2 meters distance
 - No more than 10 people on the chipping practice area while maintaining 2 meters distance
 - No more than 10 people on the practice fairway across the road while maintaining 2 meters distance

Movement around the clubhouse

Below is a map illustrating how members are to move around the clubhouse area. It is important for members to arrive only 15 minutes before their round to ensure we are not breaching social distancing rules”:



Pro-shop

- EFT only – no cash will be accepted.

- Follow the strict queuing instructions in the Proshop – Members will be asked to enter through the carpark door and leave through the cart shed side door.
- No more than 6 people in the pro-shop at any time (including staff).

Playing the game

- Stableford Medley competitions will be held daily (including Mondays). The only exception will be the final round of the Ladies Club Championships.
- Mark your own card, do not swap cards.
- Scorecards to be submitted through the scanner which will now be in the hatch area. Cards will not be handled or checked, so its critical that you ensure your card is correct, you select “Confirm” and “Finish” on the score card screen.
- No bunker rakes will be available – In bunkers, you may lift your ball, smooth the surface with your foot/club and replace your ball.
- No sand buckets will be available. Please repair your divot by chipping in the sides with your club and stepping it down with your foot.
- Do not use the ball washers – they will marked with hazard tape.
- Do not remove the flag at any time.
- Remove your ball from the hole wearing your golf glove.
- A spacer will be placed at the bottom of each flag so that you do not need to make contact with the cup when removing your ball. Do not remove these spacers.
- Refer to local rules before commencing play.

Penalties for breach

- Any member seen to be willingly ignoring these club regulations will be suspended from playing any further golf for the duration of the modified conditions.

Other conditions

- Clubhouse will be locked and administration staff only contactable on phone and email.
- All bookings are to me made online or by phone (kiosks at the clubhouse will not be available).
- Toilets will be mopped and sanitised twice daily (including on course). Please use practical sanitation techniques when using the toilets (paper towel to open/close doors etc).
