

Non-recyclable hard waste	\$50/bin
Processed timber	\$50/bin
Mattresses, couches, soft furnishings	\$50/item (all sizes)

- Chemicals
- Hazardous waste, asbestos, cement sheeting, • Car bodies plasterboard
- Construction/ demolition waste
- Paint
- Biological waste
- Prescribed industrial waste
- Liquid waste (including engine oil)
- LPG bottles







- Tyres
- Lead/acid batteries
- Chep pallets (or similar) proprietary pallets)
- Domestic waste, organics, and recycling (dispose of this waste via normal processes)
- Green waste (free collection services will be available during the annual Fire Ready weekend in November)

#### Before you go:

- Please keep quantities small. Large quantities may not be accepted at the discretion of 4 Site.
- Sort and separate all materials prior to arrival, as unsorted/ unseparated loads will be charged at the non-recyclable hard waste rate.
- Cover your load to prevent material falling from vehicles and trailers onto the roadside.

#### When you arrive:

- Follow the direction of the attendant.
- Payment by credit card/EFTPOS only (cash not accepted).

#### Hard waste disposal at other times

Resort Management is committed to Victorian Government's 10-year action plan which aims to reduce waste and set Victoria up for a more sustainable future.

Most domestic recyclables and waste can be disposed of in Mt Buller's 45 recycling drop zones. Signage identifies what can and cannot be left there. Dumping other items is illegal. If this continues, Resort Management will need to consider other measures such as the installation of CCTV cameras or a waste levy on all properties.
