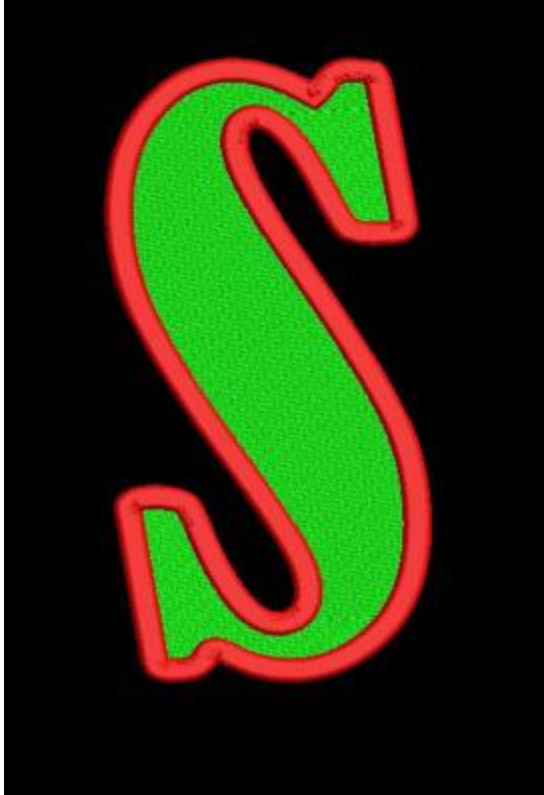

Everything Appliqué – Why Appliqué



The main reason for appliqué is to save stitches and time.

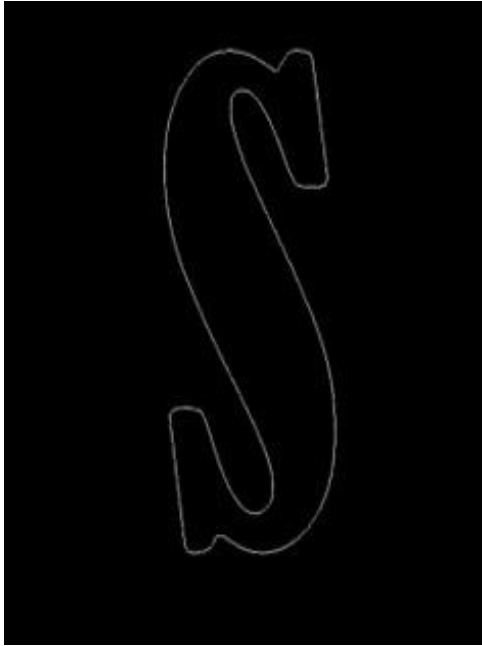
Appliqué can also give a decorative look to your embroidery.

Appliqué is most commonly used in sports apparel.



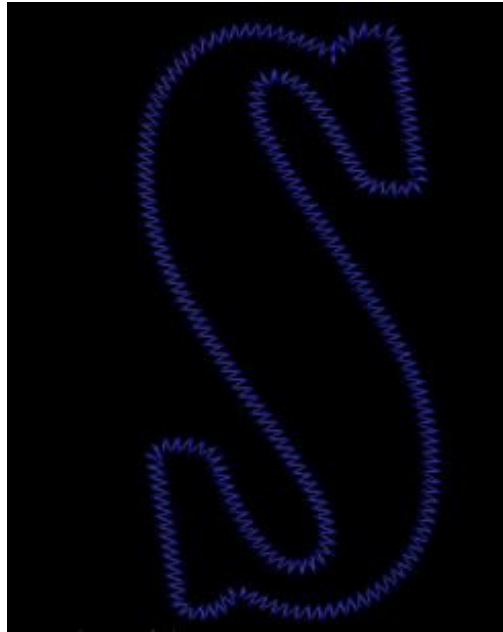
An 8" x 3" design will run around 30,000 stitches.
This will take approximately 1 hour on your machine.

Everything Appliqué – 3 Steps of the Embroidery Process



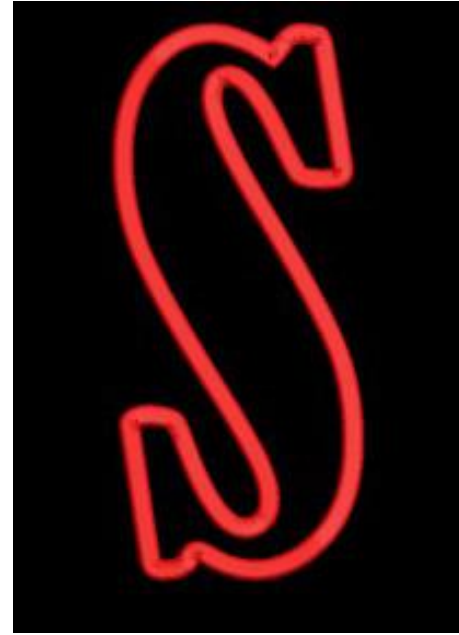
Placement Stitch

Appliqué Stitch

The final finish



An 8" x 3" Appliqué design will run around 6,500 stitches.
This will take approximately 12 minutes on your machine.

Everything Appliqué - Supplies



Friction or Roll Cutter



Laser Cutter



Appliqué Scissors



Flat Bed Cutter



"Old School" Fabric Scissors

Heat Press

If your fabric (material) is pressure sensitive or has a Heat n' Seal (BSN) coating on the back.

The Heat Press (a tool to finish the process) keeps the appliqué from puckering away from the garment as well as locking in all the stitches.



Pro Tip

For speed, volume and accuracy, use a cutting machine.

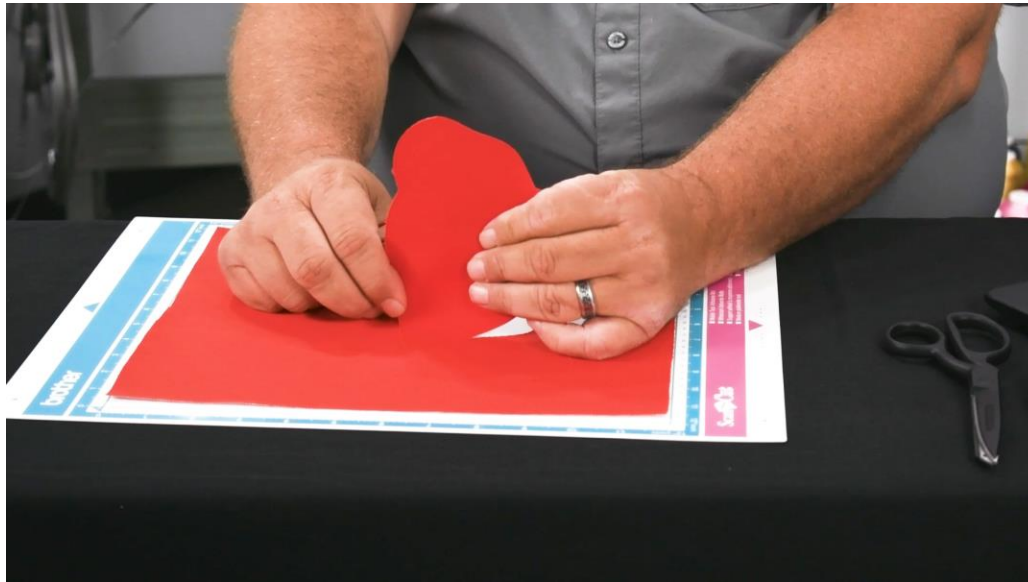

Pro Tip

When doing repetitive, large volume production, using precut materials will save time which also saves money.

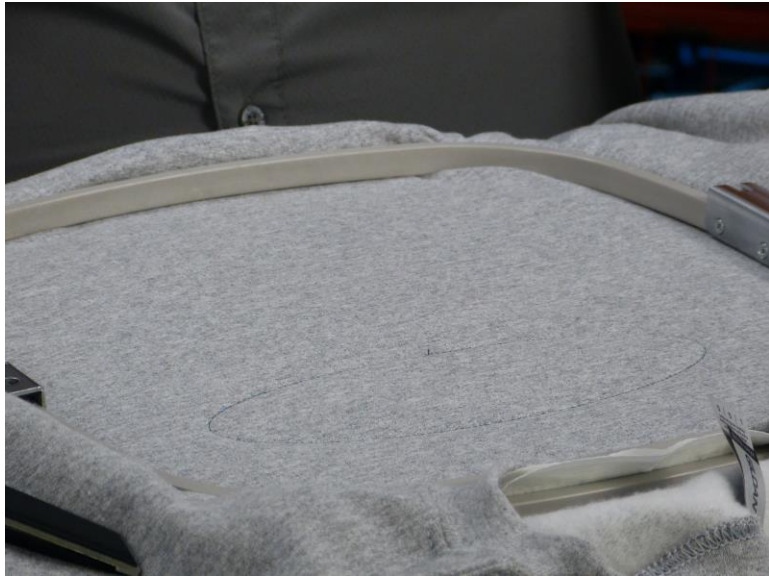
Process Overview:

Reverse Appliqué & Distressed Appliqué

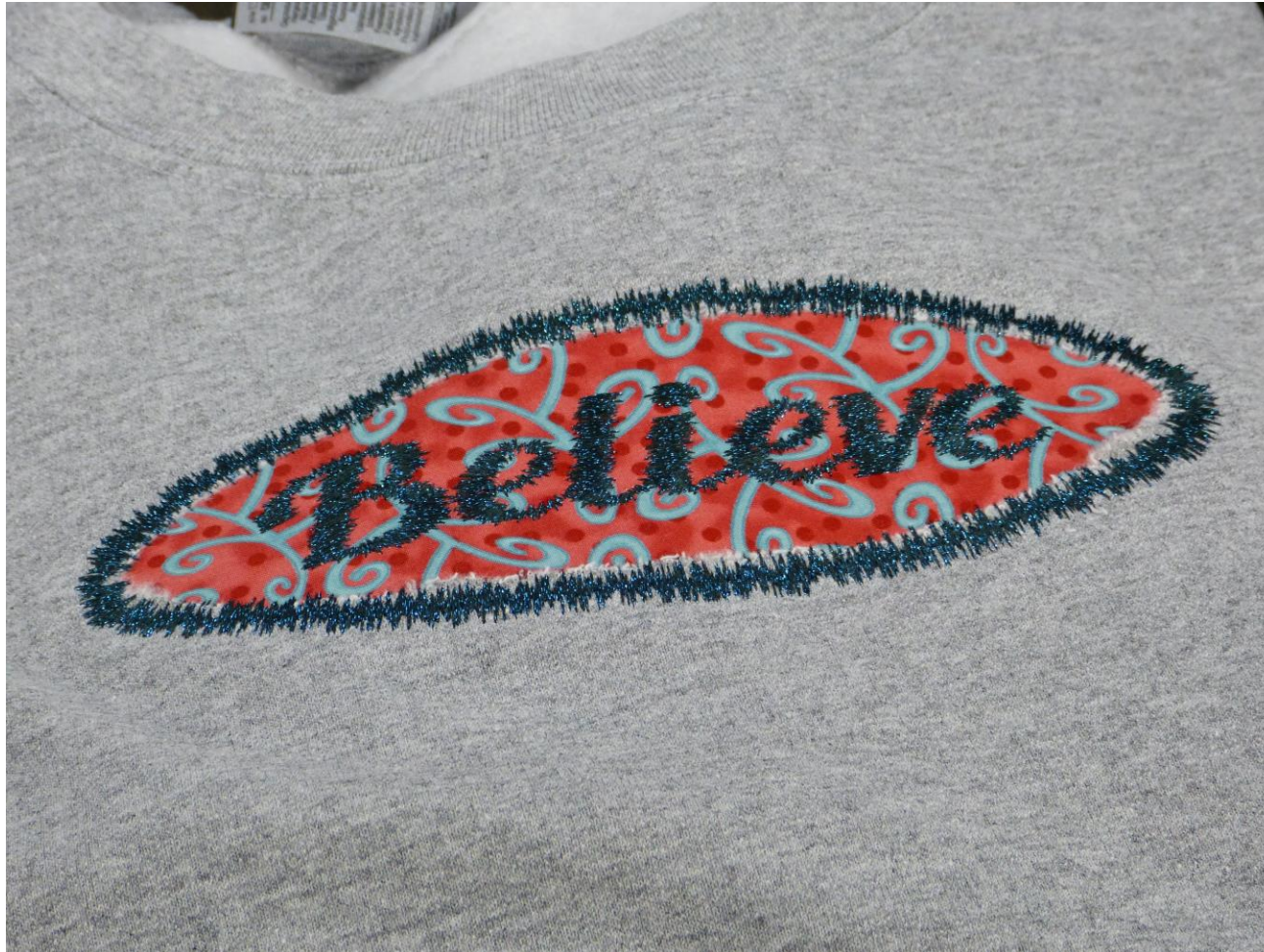
Everything Appliqué – Reverse Appliqué



Reverse Appliqué: The process of hooping the appliqué material on the inside of the shirt and cutting away the shirt for the appliqué to show through.

Everything Appliqué – Reverse Appliqué

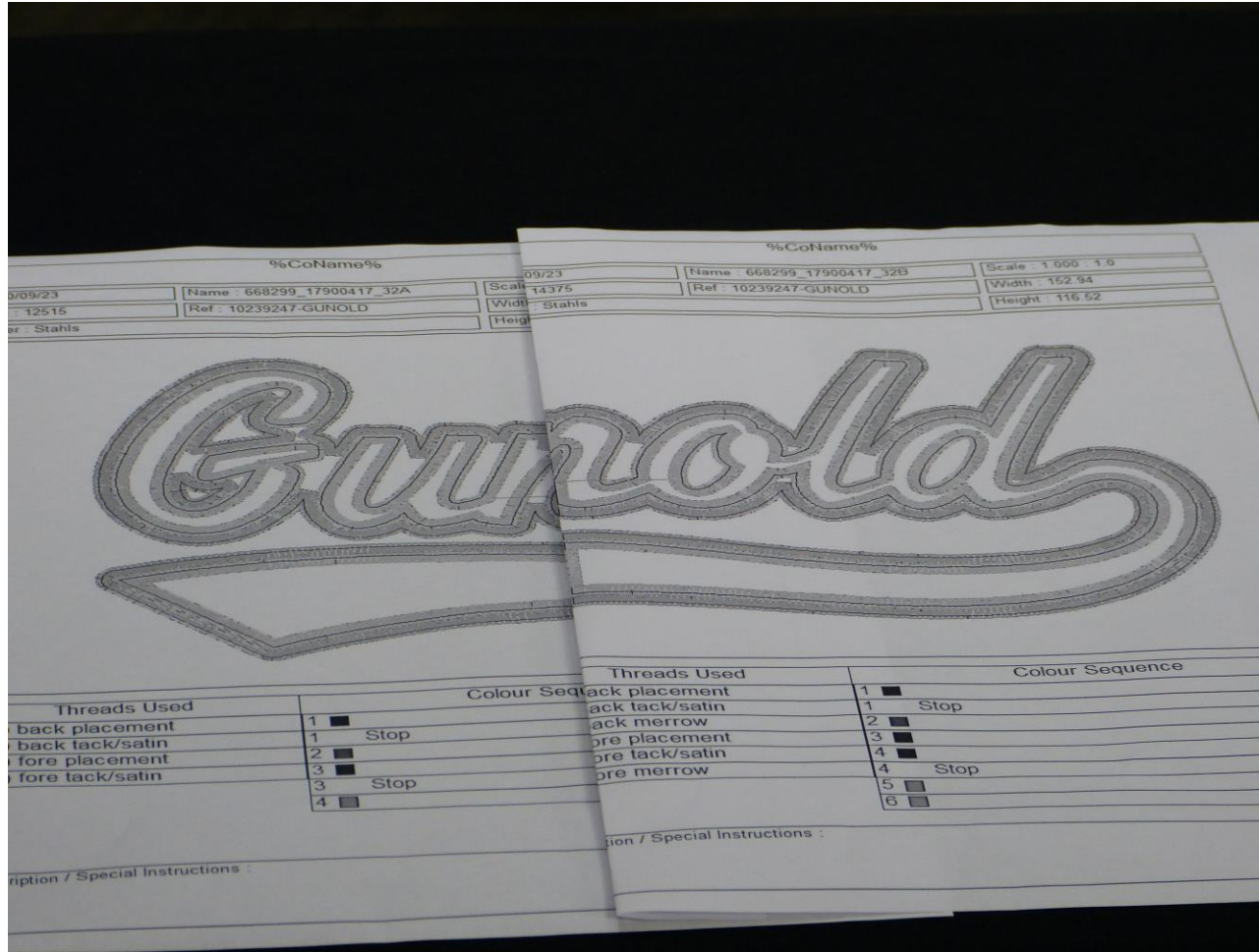
Leaving the edges frayed will give you a vintage / distressed look.

Split Front Appliqué & 2 Color Complex Appliqué

Everything Appliqué – Split Appliqué



Using a "template" printout of the design will assist in proper alignment.

Everything Appliqué – Split Appliqué



It is easier to align the design if you mark your hoops.

Suggested Markings:

1. Center of COMPLETE design
2. Center of LEFT
3. Center of RIGHT

Everything Appliqué – Split Appliqué



Pro Tip

Cut out your design and pin your template to the shirt to help keep it in place.

Everything Appliqué – Split Appliqué



Split Front Appliqué will always be done as 2 sew outs.
One sew out will overlap the other.
Suggested overlap is 1/4" to 1/2"

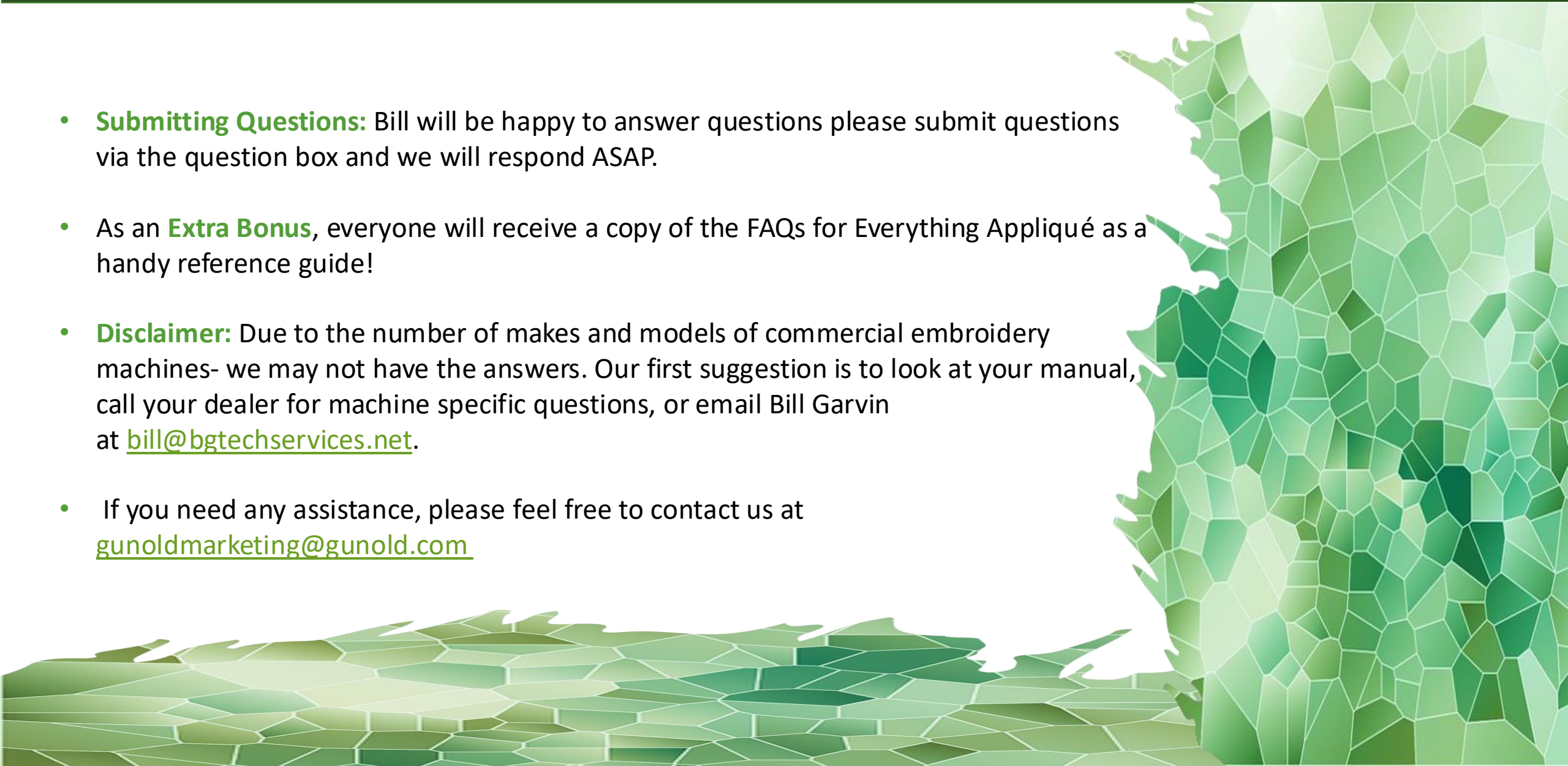
It is very important to use heat applied material and a heat press when finished to seal the appliqué to the fabric.

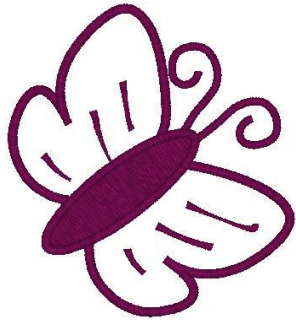
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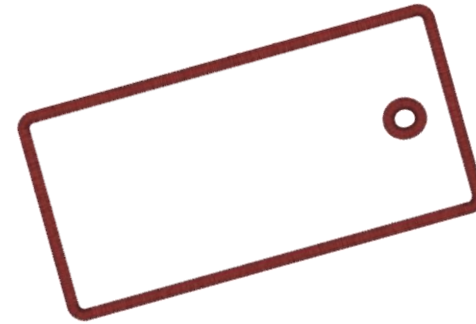
