While the Rogers Activity Center is open and operating, there is still work to be done. The City backed the construction of over \$5 million, but the City must rely on several different streams of income; including donors for the remainder of the cost.

As testament to our commitment to provide an indoor sheet of ice for our area youth, the Rogers Youth Hockey Association and the Rogers Royals Face Off Booster Club made long-term commitments to the City of Rogers and the Rogers community to pay \$65,000 and \$20,000 per year, respectively, for the next twenty years; this is above the cost of ice time for the teams.

The Pillars of Support Capital Campaign has set a goal to raise an additional \$1,000,000 to offset the borrowed funds and put the finishing touches on our beautiful arena. We need your help to meet this commitment.
