Introduction to Christianville

You've finally made it to campus, WELCOME! We are so glad you are here. Below are some basic things about our campus and logistics for you to keep in mind during your stay with us. Please let us know if there is anything we can do to help make your trip the best it can be!

Keys:

For each guest room:

- Hold onto your key throughout the day
- Lock your doors whenever no one is in the room
- Main gate keys for team coordinators available from Guest Coordinator
- Lock main door to the house at lights out or as soon as the group is in for the night
- Unlock door before breakfast

Security:

- We have a security company to keep guests and campus safe. They are armed, which is typical for security in Haiti.
- Daytime: 2 guards: one at the main gate and one at the school gate
- Night time: 6 guards: 2 at the gates, 2 stationed at certain points on campus, and 2 walking campus throughout the night.
- Lights out for guests is at 10pm
- Campus curfew is at 6pm: any staff without authorization or visitors not staying on campus must make their way home at 6pm for safety reasons during this time in country. It isn't safe to be off campus at night.

Power:

- Campus runs in a generator and battery system. Please charge phones, laptops, any devices during generator hours. Hours do sometimes vary.
- Generator Hours:
 - M-F: 7am-4pm & 5pm-8pm
 - S/S: 7am-1pm & 5pm-8pm
- Lights out at 10pm in rooms and main hall. Ceiling fans off as much as possible to save power at night. Shut off the main room switch if there is no one in the room.
- Conservation is key: shut off all fans and lights when leaving the rooms.

Water:

- Campus water is a safe source: chlorinated on site at our well by the school
- Stay hydrated! (Signs of dehydration: headaches, stomach cramps, dark urine, etc.)

Sun screen:

- Please wear it! Apply before bug spray to avoid chemical burn.

Bug spray:

- Please spray on outside of the buildings to avoid slippery floors (sunscreen as well)
- Apply especially at dusk and dawn
- Shower before bed to avoid chemical burns
- Be especially cautious when using high levels of DEET as the heat opens up your pores and you can easily get burned

Meal times:

- Sunday no breakfast
- Coffee at 7:30am in the cafeteria (set up by guest coordinator)
- Breakfast: 7:30am
- Lunch: 12pm
- Dinner: 5:30pm - when the bell rings!

Market:

- Souvenir market available on campus by request
- Merchant groups rotate according to group calendar

Children's Home:

- Schedule: ask Sue when is best to come down. On weekdays the children are in school until around 1pm, and then tutoring until 4pm.
- Guests are welcome to play in the garden with the children in the afternoons and on weekends.
- A request from Sue about phones:
Sue wants to promote relationship over technology. The kids will want you to take lots of pictures with them! Feel free to take pictures together and pictures of them, but the children are not allowed to have guest phones. Kids are kids, and we want to support her convictions about the importance of relationship with the kids over the normal kid obsession with technology.

Guest Laundry* mid week:

**Please consider packing a few laundry pods and dryer sheets for your laundry*

- Available for \$5/load during generator hours Monday-Friday for guests. Typically dry, folded and returned to the guest house by 2pm unless it rains.
- Available after 2pm M-F or on S/S during generator hours for long term guests
- Instructions: Put laundry in an extra pillow case from your room and place it by the front door of the guest house by breakfast. The Guest Coordinator will deliver to Carline, the laundry expert. Please pay \$5 per load to guest coordinator to cover tip for laundry staff and \$ for soap. If you packed your own soap, thank you! The extra money will go to Carline for her love and care of your clothes...)
