They provide biblical counseling, encouragement for our families, and opportunities to be self-sustaining with an income generation program. Their faithful service has reached many individuals and families for Christ. Many of the new believers desire to serve others, and educate their families for kingdom work.

Meet Yemamu, the director of Brook Hills Development Organization located in Korah, a community of Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. His amazing support staff consists of Beti, Ephrata, Genet, Rahel and Medi. BTM partnered with BHDO in 2020, but we have always loved the work of Yemamu and his staff since before BTM was founded. Yemamu has an incredible rescue story. He was raised with parents of Muslim faith and diseased with leprosy. A Christian organization came through Korah while he and his friends were scavenging to collect trash of value for their families. On that day, Yemamu and nine friends were sponsored and sent to boarding school. Now he is ministering to others, in the same way, he was blessed. BHDO has established the following ministries: two schools programs and will be adding a third in the near future, a



Doula program providing prenatal, postpartum care and nutrition to expecting mothers, jewelry, crafts, barber and baking apprenticeship programs, medical support and countless other opportunities for families in Korah. We are blessed to support 80 families and 11 orphans through BHDO's sponsorship program.
