Who is this little boy that captured our hearts and changed our lives forever?

HOPE. It was my (Elrond's) second mission trip to the town of Esperanza in the Dominican Republic in 2014. One afternoon, a grandmotherly widow, Iluminada, came with a young boy, of no relation to her, and knocked on the door of our hosting family. She had heard that some missionaries were in town, and was hoping that we would pray for her and the little boy, Onely. A group from our mission trip team came to the door and met with her on the front porch. When asked how she came to care for Onely and this is what she told us... "The mother of Onely stopped by her house one day saying that she would be going to one of the larger cities and would need Iluminada to take care of her son for a little bit." That 'little bit' had already been one year and counting; it has now been over 7 years.

HEALING. While we were speaking with Iluminada, we learned that the reason for Onely being in the stroller was that he was immobile. He suffers from Spastic Quadriplegia that prevents him from walking, a condition that he was born with. As Onely continues to grow, his condition worsens with continued rigid tendons resulting in severe chronic pain and restricted mobility. The doctors have recommended multiple surgeries which include bi-lateral hip surgery and tendon surgeries on his lower legs. Visit our website at www.kingsviewsp.org/ for more surgical details.

JOY. We are encouraged by the doctor's report as the initial benefit of the surgeries will be Onely's relief from his pain. However, the doctors have all stated that he also should be able to stand for short periods of time (up to one hour) and, in rare cases, Onely might even be able to walk with assistance! We can not overstate how incredibly life-changing these surgeries will be!



To this day, Iluminada continues to take care of Onely as her own son. She is his sole care provider. Iluminada is also at an age where lifting Onely from wheelchair to bed (and vice-versa) and simple tasks such as pushing him in his wheelchair to and from the church are getting more difficult. We are certain that Onely's decrease in pain and the possibility of being able to stand and even walk, will offer a tremendous blessing and a relief to her also.
