



Your Church Can Get Involved and Partner with the Village of Mtsiliza, Malawi



The village of Mtsiliza lies inside Lilongwe, the capital city of Malawi. It is home to more than 10,000 people, ranging from destitute to middle-class. Much of the population of Mtsiliza is made up of orphaned and destitute children living with families or caregivers who are unable to properly provide for them. Malnutrition, a lack of education, and a lack of medical care are common problems here. Due to the high rate of HIV/AIDS and the toll it has taken on this community, many families are headed by widows, the elderly, and in some cases, children. Christian, Muslim, and tribal religions all coexist in Mtsiliza.

There are currently over 300 children enrolled in COTN's Mtsiliza Village Partnership Program. Alongside partners like you, COTN is able to provide children in Mtsiliza with education, nutrition, and medical care. COTN is helping to build a secondary school at our nearby ministry center and has provided resources like clothes, shoes, and blankets, as well as Christian discipleship training, HIV/AIDS education and testing, and trauma counseling. Mtsiliza is home to the COTN Widows Program, where women can learn a trade and earn an income to better support their families.
