



Your Church Can Get Involved and Partner with the Village of Los Robles, Dominican Republic



Los Robles, whose name translates to “The Oaks” or “Strong People,” is a remote, extremely poor community. It is a batey (pronounced *BAH-tay*)—one of several shantytown work camps built in the 1960s to house migrant sugarcane workers from Haiti. Most of these workers never obtained legal citizenship in the Dominican Republic. Today, their descendants are not legal citizens either and are denied access to social services, including education and medical care. Compounding these problems are the issues of teen pregnancy and unemployment due to the mechanization of the sugar industry.

We currently have around 140 children enrolled in our Village Partnership Program in Los Robles. Our facilities now include a seven-room school where children in kindergarten through eighth grade can learn, play, and eat each day. Alongside caring partners like you, COTN has also helped build a church and set up a clean water system for the people of Los Robles, as well as has hosting Bible studies and fun summer camps for the children.
