INTRODUCTION

When we endeavor to cover what the Word of God has to say about the subject of Healing, we soon encounter the fact that not all believers agree.

There are many misconceptions and questions about healing that I hope to address in this book.

Some say "God won't heal everyone." Some may say, "I've prayed and if it's God's will for me to be healed, I'll be healed right now."

Some might believe they must go to a traveling evangelist in order to be healed. After all, the person to pray for them must have a "ministry" of healing. Some think God will heal *some* sicknesses, just not *all* sicknesses. Others believe that healing and miracles are a thing of the past, having died off with the last apostle. The list goes on and on.

Most believers will at least acknowledge the fact that God <u>CAN</u> heal if He wants to, they just aren't always sure whether God wants to or how to obtain their healing <u>IF</u> He wants to heal them.

I hope to clear up some of these misconceptions by writing this helpful booklet. In doing so, I am going to present 10 Biblical reasons why we can rest upon the fact that it is God's will for people to be healed.

So enjoy the journey as we explore the Word of God together.

JESUS WAS A HEALER

The scriptures are very clear regarding how Jesus felt about healing the sick. In fact, Jesus had a widely-known reputation for healing people.

"Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them."

Mathew 4:24

His reputation was such that people expected if they could just get themselves to Jesus, they would be healed.

"And He came down with them and stood on a level place with a crowd of His disciples and a great multitude of people from all Judea and all Jerusalem, and from the seacoast of Tyre and Sidon, who came to hear Him and be healed of all their diseases."

Luke 6:17

Jesus wasn't selective of who He would heal. He didn't discriminate over who should receive healing. Healing wasn't only offered to those who were educat-

ed or those who lived in certain parts of the city. He didn't leave some sick, but healed all who came to Him for healing.

"When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed <u>all</u> who were sick."

Matthew 8:16

"But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them <u>all</u>."

Matthew 12:12

So we can see by the scriptures listed that Jesus had a reputation for getting people healed. I want you to notice that in each of them, He healed them *ALL*. It doesn't say that He healed only those with coughs or minor ailments. It doesn't say that He would only pray for the seriously sick or terminally ill and turned away everyone else. No. In fact, it says He healed them *ALL*. Jesus was a healer.

2.

JESUS DID HIS FATHER'S WILL ON THE EARTH

Everything that Jesus did here on the Earth was to show us the nature of His Father God in Heaven. Jesus brought the will of God in on the scene. He was all God, but He came to the earth and became all man with the purpose of redeeming man from the bondages of sin, sickness, and poverty. What He did was reflective of heaven on the earth.

"If you had known Me, you would have known the Father also. And from now on, you know Him and have seen Him." John 14:17

Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

John 14:9

"How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him." Acts 10:38

The nature of God is healing and Jesus displayed that nature (will) on the earth.

3.

GOD'S WORD IS MEDICINE

We've determined that God is a healing God and that it was His desire to see people healed. You might think, "That was great for those who were able to be in Jesus' meetings 2000 years ago; He healed them all. But what about us who weren't able to attend His meetings? Is there a way for God to get healing to us?"

I've got good news for you! God has made provision for us to receive our healing and it is found in Proverbs chapter 4:

My son, give attention to my <u>sayings</u>. Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart; for they are life to those who find them, and <u>health</u> to all their flesh. Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life.

Proverbs 4:20-23

God is telling us that the Word of God, which is God's written will, can produce healing to our flesh.

Most of us are used to running to the medicine cabinet or to the doctor to obtain the right kind of medicine to help us get healed of our sicknesses. There's

nothing wrong with taking medicine. Thank God He has gifted mankind with the ability to use certain earthly elements to assist us in getting well. But, what He is telling us is when the Word of God becomes a part of you, it becomes like "medicine" to you. It will produce healing in you.

You see, an interesting thing happens when a human being hears the Word of God, believes it, and acts upon it: a thing called "FAITH" is produced in his heart. See what it says in Hebrews:

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:1

And then again in Romans we see how faith comes...

So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:17

Although there were many people who were healed, like we saw before where Jesus healed "ALL," there are 19 individual cases in the Gospels where healings were highlighted for our observation. **12** of those specifically mentioned FAITH as a factor in their healing. Let me give you three examples:

Jesus encountered two blind men in Matthew chapter 9.

Jesus asked them "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" Then He touched their eyes, saying, "According to your <u>faith</u> let it be to you." And their eyes were opened.

Matthew 9:27-29

A woman came to Jesus seeking healing for her daughter in Matthew chapter 15.

Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great is your <u>faith!</u> Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour.

Matthew 15:28

In Luke, chapter 18, we read where a blind beggar who knew Jesus' reputation for healing cried out to Him as He passed by.

"Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me."
Then Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has made you well."

Luke 18:42

What do you think Jesus was doing at those meetings that people were being brought to? He was teaching them the Word of God to build up their faith, so they would be able to receive their healing. You can see this really clearly in the following verse.

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the

gospel of the kingdom, and <u>healing</u> every sickness and every disease among the people.

Matthew 9:35

Let's think about this for a moment. The very first thing Jesus did was teach them. He gave them **information**. Without information, you are ignorant of a subject. Jesus had information He wanted them to know.

The next thing He did was to preach to them. Teaching is information and preaching is **inspiration**. He preached to them the gospel of the kingdom. A definition of the word "gospel" is "good news."

What is good news to the person in poverty? They don't need to be poor!

What is good news to the person who is caught up in sin and destined for hell? They can repent and be saved!

What is good news to the person who is sick? That they can be healed!

So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, Because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor. He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed, to preach the acceptable year of the Lord."

Then He closed the book, and gave it back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. And He began to say to them, "Today this scripture is fulfilled in your hearing."

Luke 4:16-21

The account in Matthew then goes on to say after He **taught** and **preached** to them, He **healed** them. First, He informed them of what was theirs and then faith followed; faith to be healed. Remember, faith comes by hearing the Word of God.

When you have faith to be healed, you will do whatever it takes. There is an account of a woman with an issue of blood. She had been to many doctors, spent all the money she had trying to get well, and could find no healing for her predicament.

When she heard Jesus and saw the miracles that accompanied His teaching and preaching, faith to be healed came. She believed that if she could just get to Him and touch Him, she too would be healed.

It was a difficult thing for this woman to push

through the multitudes to get to Jesus. She was determined and even confessed with her mouth that she would be healed. (Out of the abundance of your heart, your mouth speaks-Matt 12:34.)

Let's see what happened...

And suddenly, a woman who had a flow of blood for twelve years came from behind and touched the hem of His garment. For she said to herself, "If only I may touch His garment, I shall be made well." But Jesus turned around, and when He saw her He said, "Be of good cheer, daughter; your faith has made you well." And the woman was made well from that hour.

Matthew 9:20-23

So faith plays an important part in healing. The list goes on, but Jesus also talks of what happens when there is NO faith.

Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?"

So Jesus said to them, "Because of your unbelief [lack of faith]; for assuredly, I say to you, if you have faith as a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you."

Matthew 17:19 & 20

So they were offended at Him. But Jesus said to them, "A prophet is not without

honor except in his own country and in his own house." Now He did not [could not] do many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

Matthew 13:57 & 58

Let me see if I can put it in easier terms. Faith is believing and trusting God—so much so that you believe without a doubt that what He said is true.

The man with the son who was demon possessed, asked Jesus a question.

He asked Jesus, "If you can do anything, have compassion on us and help us."

Mark 9:22

Sounds like some of our prayers: "If it be your will, please heal me." BUT, if you are not confident – settled that Jesus wants you well, you won't receive what you need from Him. Jesus went on to tell this man,

"If you can believe, all things are possible to him who believes"

I appreciate the man's honesty, when he answered back to the Lord.

"Lord I believe...help my unbelief!"

Mark 9:23-24

So we know that faith for healing comes from hearing the Word of God (concerning healing), and believing it, but how do we get faith to work for us? You activate FAITH by your words, and your actions.

For she <u>said</u> to herself, "If only I may touch His garment, I shall be made well."

Matthew 9:21

For assuredly, I say to you, whoever <u>says</u> to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

Mark 11:23

So God's Word is medicine. When you take it every day (by reading and meditating on it) and apply it every day (by speaking it forth), it will work for you.

This is why it is so important for you as a believer to make church attendance a priority. A new believer is ignorant of the Bible, what it says, and how it applies to their lives personally. A believer that has been saved for a while still needs to grow. When you attend church and regularly hear the Word, you grow in your faith (remember Romans 10:17). As you grow, you begin and continue to believe God for the things He says you can have and your life begins and continues to line up with the Word of God. You experience the blessing of God in your life.

I will list scriptures for you to study and confess each day at the end of this book. Just as natural medicine must be taken every day to insure healing, confessing the Word of God must be done every day as well. It will build your faith in God's ability.

4 GOD'S ORIGINAL DESIGN

God's original design for the earth was for a perfect man and woman to live in it, be fruitful, multiply and fill the earth. Sometimes, we lose track of His plan. In Genesis 1, God said...

"Let us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness, let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.

Genesis 1:26

Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day.

Genesis 1:31

God was pleased with what He had created. I'd like to ask the question, "Did God create man so he could be sick and diseased?" No. In fact, we see that we were created in His image. Is God sickly? No, so why do so many of us continue to doubt whether God wants us well? Which day was it that He created sickness?

Sickness and death entered the world through sin and Jesus bore that sickness so we wouldn't have to bear it. See 1 Peter 2:24.

5 IT'S GOD'S WILL IN HEAVEN

God's Word gives us a glimpse of what heaven is like. In Revelation 21 He says He will wipe away every tear from their eyes. (vs. 4) There shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain.

So we can clearly see and understand that heaven is a place of health and joy. When Jesus taught His disciples to pray, He prayed for there to be heaven on the earth.

Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your Name. Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

Matthew 6:10

God doesn't have one will on earth and another in heaven. He wants His will to be unhindered here upon the earth. God wants His will done on the earth!

It really doesn't make much sense to say we want His will to be done here yet fight to stay sick. Sometimes we can be sincere in our beliefs and yet be sincerely wrong.

A boy I know attends a multi-denominational Christian school where some believe that "healing" isn't for us today. One day, as his Bible teacher was explaining how it's presumptuous to try to know what God's will is for us concerning healing, this young man

asked the obvious question:

"If you don't believe it's God's will for you to be healed, and you claim to be a Christian who wants God's will, then why do you purposely go against God's will by taking medication, trying to get healed?"

It's as if we think it's OK for us to get healed as long as we do it ourselves, but never that God could have anything to do with it.

Our thinking is messed up. We make excuses to explain away why our prayers don't seem to be answered. When the truth is, God wants us well and maybe we haven't done what we should be doing to receive our healing. Sometimes, we aren't praying the right way. Sometimes, we aren't praying in faith.

The only way you can take medicine or visit a doctor with a clear conscience is to believe God wants you well. He says everyone in heaven is healthy and we are to pray His will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

6 THE ORIGIN OF SICKNESS

To determine it is God's will for us to be healed, we need to be confident we know where sickness originated from. The Bible says that mankind suffers sickness because we are under a curse. This curse came upon us because of the original sin in the garden of Eden.

As we have already discovered, God created man in His own image. Adam was not designed by God to be sick and die prematurely on the earth. He was designed to have fellowship and communion with God. However, Adam and Eve were both given a free choice. When they were tempted to disobey God and yielded to that temptation, they sinned. They had been given control of the earth, to tend it and take care of it. The original design was for them to do this with Godly influence.

By compromising, they allowed Satan's influence to reign in the earth rather than God's. When you separate yourself from God, you separate yourself from Godly healing.

"Therefore just as through one man, sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned..."

Romans 5:12

"Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so, through one man's right-eous act, the free gift came to all men, resulting in justification of life."

Romans 5:18

To further emphasize that sickness isn't from God, we see over and over in the scriptures where sickness is referred to as "evil" (see Psalm 41:7) or having originated from the devil himself

"How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him"

Acts 10:38

"But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, 'Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity [sickness],'..."

"...So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?" Luke 14:12, 16

"He who sins is of the devil, for the devil has sinned from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil."

1 John 3:8

"The thief does not come except to steal, kill and to destroy. I have come that they might have life and that they might have it more abundantly."

John 10:10

7 WE HAVE A COVENANT WITH GOD

We can be confident of the fact that God wants us healed by the simple fact that He made a covenant (agreement) with us as Christians. When you received Jesus as your savior, by faith, you received the covenant He made on our behalf.

In Exodus, after crossing the Red Sea, God told the children of Israel, through Moses, that if they would follow diligently after His voice and do all that He commanded, He would keep them well.

"...For I am the Lord who heals you."

Exodus 15:26b

He later repeats what blessings belong to His people, if they will choose to put Him first place. In Deuteronomy chapter 7, He tells us He will keep His covenant with us by loving us, multiplying us, causing our lands to produce, our flocks to increase, and then concludes with verse 15 saying He will take away sickness from us.

This agreement or covenant God made was with Abraham. So why do we think we can partake of the blessings of that covenant? Because we belong to Christ Jesus.

"Therefore know that only those who are of faith are sons of Abraham. And the scripture, fore-seeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham beforehand, saying, "In you all the nations shall be blessed." So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham."

"And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed. And heirs according to the promise."

Galatians 3:7-9 & 29

But now He has obtained a more excellent ministry, inasmuch as He is also Mediator of a better covenant, which was established on better promises.

Hebrews 8:6

8 SICKNESS IS PART OF THE CURSE OF THE LAW

There is a difference between the "curse of the law," and the "curse of the fall." In Genesis chapter 3, as a result of the <u>Fall</u> (Adam and Eve sinning in the garden and allowing the devil to have headship over the earth) mankind would suffer death, tend to the ground in order to grow food, work hard, even suffer pain in childbirth. Where once man had been able to live in a peaceful paradise, now the earth would be subject to the destroying influence of the devil. As men and women, we are all born into this world and therefore into that curse—the curse of the Fall.

The curse of the Law is different. We can choose to change our headship, even though we can't change where we live. The earth still brings forth thorns and weeds and women still have pain in childbirth, etc. but God made a covenant with Abraham and the curses that are spelled out in Deuteronomy 28 for being disobedient to the Lord, do not belong to us. In fact, every sickness and disease the devil would like to inflict upon us is listed in the curse of the Law (Deut 28:21-66). As Christians, we have been redeemed from that curse!

"Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith." Gal 3:13-14

9 WE HAVE AUTHORITY OVER SICKNESS

Since we have determined that sickness is a work of the devil, we can take our authority as a believer and rebuke sickness when it tries to affect our bodies.

"I have given you authority to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you."

Luke 10:19

He empowered His disciples to go and take authority over sickness and disease in Matthew 10.

"And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of diseases."

Matthew 10:1

Jesus was so serious about getting the message out of how God wants people healed, that in Luke chapter 10, He appointed seventy more of His followers to go out two by two and take the message they were hearing to the region around them.

In vs. 9 He tells them to heal the sick and then to

tell them the kingdom of God is at hand. When they returned, they remarked to Jesus that, "Even the demons are subject to us in Your Name."

To suggest that it is not God's will to heal us cannot be supported by scripture. In contrast, the Word of God overwhelmingly supports His willingness and great desire for us to be healed and whole.

THE CHURCH IN THE BOOK OF ACTS IS A PATTERN FOR CHURCHES TODAY

The Book of Acts is a pattern or blueprint for today's church. So if healing happened then, and was expected to happen then, healing should be happening in our churches today. In fact, all signs and wonders that are in the Book of Acts should be signs and wonders for today as well.

Here are just a few examples of healing in the early church:

Lame Man at the Gate Beautiful -Acts 3

A man who had been lame from birth, daily was brought to the gate of the temple to beg money from those who passed by on the way into the temple. One morning, Peter and John passed by and encountered the man.

Instead of giving him money, Peter, full of the Holy Spirit said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give to you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk."

He took him by the hand and lifted him up. He gained strength in his legs and ankles and was healed. He walked into the temple with them. Walking, leaping and praising God.

If it happened then, it can happen now.

Philip the Evangelist–Acts 8

Philip saw many lame and paralyzed folks healed as he held meetings in Samaria, teaching about Jesus and what He had done for them. The Bible says there was great joy in the city!

If it happened then, it can happen now.

Jesus Heals Aeneas Through Peter-Acts 9:32

Peter traveled through all parts of the country, sharing the Gospel. When he came to Lydda, he held a meeting for the believers there.

He found a man there who had been bedridden for eight years and was paralyzed. Full of faith, Peter said to Aeneas, "Jesus the Christ heals you. Arise, and make your bed." He arose immediately and was healed.

If it happened then, it can happen now.

Paul's Witness on Malta -Acts 28

The ship Paul was on had run aground and was destroyed in a fierce storm. As they were on the island getting warm around the fire, Paul was bitten by a deadly viper. It should have killed him, however, he just shook it off and continued with warming himself.

Word quickly got around that Paul had not even been affected by the poison. The leading citizen of the island, Publius, invited Paul to pray for his sick father. He prayed, laid hands upon him and he was healed. Upon seeing that, every other sick person on the island came to have Paul pray for them. They were all healed.

If it happened then, it can happen now.

Ananias [a believer] lays hands on Saul—Acts 9:17

One argument regarding healing is that only the apostles were able to lay hands for healing. However, this simply is not supported by scripture. In this verse we see where God spoke to Ananias and told him to lay hands upon Saul, who was blind. He did as he was commanded and Saul regained his sight.

If it happened then, it can happen now.

We are writing the last chapter of Acts

When Jesus died and ascended into heaven, He gave us the Holy Spirit to help us continue His work. With the Holy Spirit living big within us, we can carry on the commission Jesus empowered us to do.

If it happened then, it can happen now.

"And these signs will follow those who believe: In my name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues; they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick and they will recover."

Mark 16:17-18
