The Beyer Farm Trail offers a tranquil escape and educates the public about the surrounding wetlands, wildlife and vegetation. It is a favorite for running, walking, and cycling.

The trail is part of the Lake City Greenway. It is located on the edge of Pike Lake in Warsaw and leads through woods and wetlands. It connects to the Pike Lake beach and Lucerne Park.




Trails: 1.3 miles Acreage: 46.8 acres

Enjoy hiking through prairie, wetland and wooded areas, while discovering beautiful spring and late summer flowers. The preserve is home to a unique blend of trees, including beech, maple, tulip, sycamore, black cherry and blue ash. Several small ponds and a robust, flowering prairie complete the picturesque landscape. Bock Nature Preserve is open daily from dawn to dusk.

Heritage Trail: 5.2 miles · Winona Lake Trails: 9.7 miles

The Heritage Trail, a section of the Lake City Greenway, runs through the town of Winona Lake, along the lake and through the woods, connecting the Winona Lake park, beach, splash pad, and the Grace College campus. It features artwork that interprets attributes of the heritage of Winona Lake.

The Winona Lake Trails are challenging mountain bike pathways. They include uphill climbs, quick descents, and fun, flat sections. (Note: the trails may evolve from season to season).



The Chinworth Bridge Trail is part of the Lake City Greenway, and lets visitors ride over the Tippecanoe River. This historic iron bridge dates to 1897 and provides a peaceful getaway.


This preserve is a mature hardwood forest that provides the public with a glimpse of Indiana's pre-agricultural natural history. Massive, untouched trees, including oak, hickory, and tulip poplar tower above a rich understory of native flowers and sedges. The rolling forested hills have one of the most spectacular wildflower displays in the Midwest.

This trail educates guests on the state's natural heritage and what they can do to preserve it in Kosciusko County.



Boardwalk: .5 miles Acreage: 445 acres

This area was set aside to preserve habitat resources for a variety of plant and animal species. It is comprised of grassland, wetland, upland forest and lake habitat.

The particularly best reason to visit Pisgah is to look for marsh species that are hard to find, such as Common Gallinule, Soras, Green Heron, Virginia Rail, American Coot, and Black-billed Cuckoo.

The Conklin Bay Boardwalk extends the existing eleven miles of trail with a one-third-mile wetland boardwalk along with two-thirds more miles of concrete trail.

The new section of trail opened officially in May of 2020 and runs through the Rolland Wetland Conservation Area. Plus, it includes four overlook sections for visitors to admire the view.

The Wawasee Area Conservancy Foundation Centre, also known as the Levinson-LaBrosse Lakes and Wetlands Education Center, is located nearby on 40 acres of wetland, woods, and lakeshore. It provides educational programs, workshops, and a place for the community to gather. The Wawasee Area Conservancy Foundation is dedicated to protecting the local wetlands and wildlife in the area.


Wetland Trail: .3 miles Buck Island Trail: .6 miles Acreage: 140 acres

The Buck Island Trail is located close to the Between the Lake Preserve around Mud Lake. This area is owned by the Wawasee Area Conservancy Foundation (WACF), who is committed to protecting the natural wetlands in the area. The WACF hopes to create an environment where the community can step outside and appreciate the outdoors.

Situated near Wawasee Lake, Conklin Bay Wetlands, and the Levinson-LaBrosse Lakes and Wetlands Education Center, the Syracuse Lake Wetland Trails consist of three trails. On these trails, you can see beautiful wetlands, wooded areas, and lakeshore. Trails are open from dawn to dusk every day, so feel free to take a walk anytime at this beautiful location.












WILDWOOD NATURE PRESERVE

This preserve has a small pond surrounded by forest, vernal pools, a pine planting, numerous wetlands and a prairie. There are oak, hickory and many more species of trees as well as numerous species of wildflowers.

Various birds can be seen, from wood ducks to several species of woodpeckers, including redheaded and pileated.

The variety of terrain provides habitats for a wide cross section of local wildlife.














