- Connection to blue spaces is beneficial for human physical and mental health.
- Many recreational activities are dependent on lakes and streams.

Caring for Blue Spaces

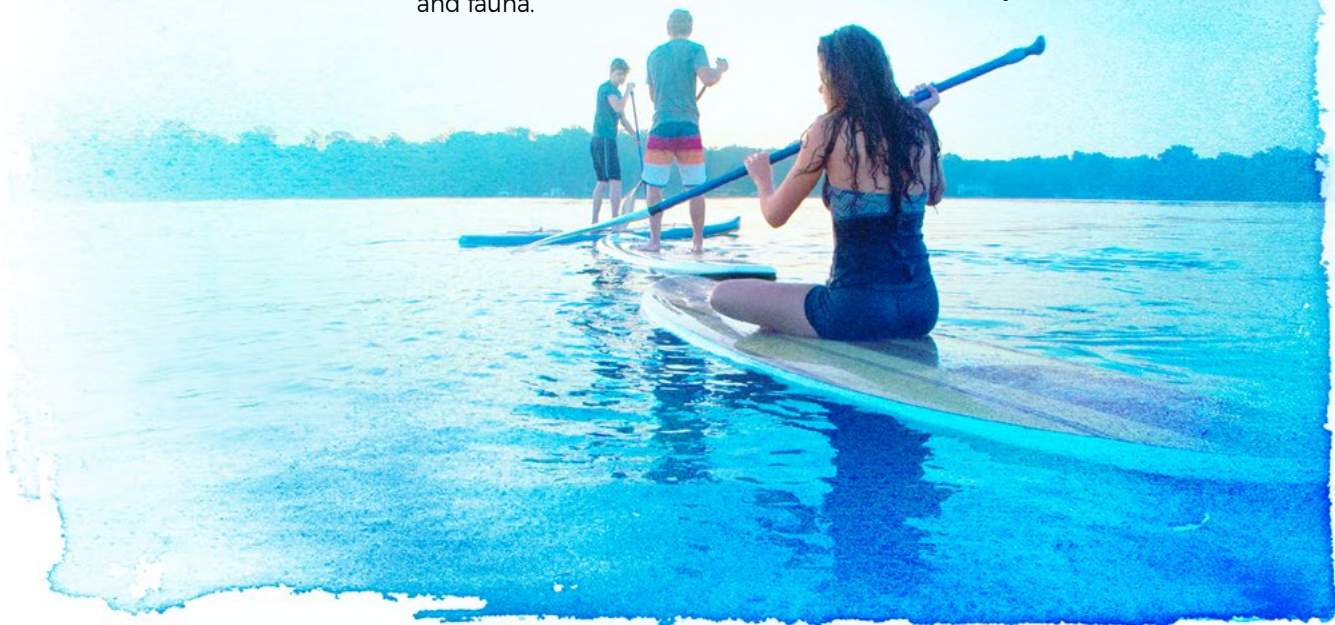
- Observe and respect ecozones and other protected areas.
- Stay in at least 10 ft. of water when boating at any speed that creates a wake to protect the lake.
- Support organizations that protect Kosciusko County's blue spaces.
- Educate yourself on native flora and fauna.

How to Travel Responsibly

- Leave no trace by picking up litter and leaving habitat intact.
- Do not feed or disturb water birds or other wildlife.
- Make sure you have the proper license when fishing.
- Respect private property and shorelines.

Safety During Activities

- Have the correct number of personal flotation devices in your watercraft.
- Follow local and state regulations for boating and other activities.
- Watch the forecast for inclement weather.
- If traveling alone, let someone know your plans.
- Stay close to shore on paddle boards and kayaks on busier lakes.
