

RUN away from WILLIAM DOUGLASS, of Staten-Island, a Negro Man, named GEORGE, aged about 22 Years, near 5 Feet 10 Inches high, slender built, talks a good deal upon the New-England Accent; large Eyes with a good deal of White in them: Had on when he went away, a speckled Flannel Shirt, a Pair of twill'd bagging Trowsers piec'd, a Pair of black Stockings, new Pumps with carved Silver Buckles, a homespun brown upper Jacket, and a red Waistcoat without Sleeves under, lin'd with buff-colour'd Flannel, a Felt Hat not half worn. Any Person taking up, and securing the above Negro in any Gaol, so that his Master can have him again, shall receive the Sum of Forty Shillings, and all reasonable Charges, paid by me WILLIAM DOUGLASS, living on Staten-Island.
