

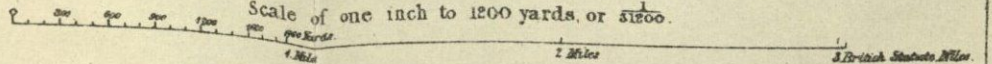


The reclamations since 1816 till 1890 are indicated by the red lines.
