



**Friday, March 9, 2012 – Quarterfinals - Game 4
#3 Xavier 70, #6 Dayton 69**

XAVIER NOTES (20-11)

> Xavier advances to its eleventh Atlantic 10 Championship semifinal, the first since 2010 when the Musketeers fell to Richmond, 89-85, in overtime. Xavier has advanced to the semifinals in ten of the past eleven years

> Xavier is now 24-12 in 17 appearances at the Atlantic 10 Championship, 2-2 under head coach Chris Mack. The Musketeers have made the A-10 Championships in each of their 17 seasons in the conference. Xavier's .667 championship winning percentage is second among all conference school while the 24 wins is fourth

> The Musketeers are now 13-3 all-time in Atlantic 10 Championships quarterfinal games and have won their last ten contests in the quarterfinal round

> Xavier is now 5-5 all-time in Atlantic 10 Championships games at Boardwalk Hall

> Xavier has now won 20 games for the seventh straight season and 15th in last 16 years

> Tu Holloway netted a game-high 21 points to bring his career total to 1,727, moving him to eighth on the Xavier all-time scoring list

> Tu Holloway registered two assists to bring his career total to 537, third on all-time school's all-time assists list

> Tu Holloway netted 21 points for his team-leading 13th 20-point game of the season. It was Holloway's second straight and fourth overall, 20-point game at the Atlantic 10 Championships

> Mark Lyons finished with 12 points to increase his career total to 1,133, 33rd on the Musketeers' all-time scoring list

> Mark Lyons notched double figures in scoring in his ninth straight and 26th overall game this season

> Kenny Frease grabbed seven rebounds and now has 698 career boards, 19th on the Xavier all-time rebounding list

> Kenny Frease finished with 17 points, his fifth straight double digit scoring game

DAYTON NOTES (20-12)

- > Dayton is now 20-16 all-time in 17 appearances at the Atlantic 10 Championship, 0-1 under head coach Archie Miller. The Flyers have advanced to the championships in each of their 17 years in the conference
- > The Flyers made their 14th appearance in the Atlantic 10 Championship quarterfinals and are now 6-8 in quarterfinal games
- > Dayton is now 7-6 all-time in Atlantic 10 Championships games at Boardwalk Hall
- > The Dayton class of 2012 (Luke Fabrizius, Chris Johnson, Josh Parker and Paul Williams) has accounted for 94 victories, the second-winningest class in UD history
- > The Flyers shot 86.4% (19-22) from the free throw stripe, the 15th straight game the Flyers have shot better than 70% from the charity stripe. Dayton is 17-8 on the year when shooting 70% or better from the line
- > Dayton is now 13-5 on the year when leading at the half
- > Chris Johnson appeared in his 137th career game, tying him with former teammates London Warren and Kurt Huelsman for the Dayton all-time record
- > Chris Johnson netted five points to bring his career total to 1,459, 21st on the Dayton all-time scoring list. He also sank one three-pointer to bring his four-year total to 236, fifth on the Flyers' career list
- > Kevin Dillard dished out six assists to bring his season total to 192, the third best single season total in school history
- > Kevin Dillard scored in double figures with a team-high 18 points, his eighth straight double digit scoring game and his 13th in the last 14 games
- > Kevin Dillard has at least one steal in 24 of the 32 Dayton games this year
- > The Flyers are now 11-4 this season in games where Paul Williams scores in double figures (he had 11 tonight)

A-10 CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- > Xavier and Dayton met for the seventh time at the Atlantic 10 Championships with Xavier holding a 6-1 lead in all-time A-10 Championship meetings
- > Xavier and Dayton have met at the Atlantic 10 Championships in each of the past three years and in five of the last six
- > The number three seed is now 4-2 in the quarterfinals of the Atlantic 10 Championship since the conference changed the format in 2005-06
- > The number six seed is now 2-4 in the quarterfinals of the Atlantic 10 Championship since the conference changed the format in 2005-06
- > The number three seed advances to the semifinals for the third straight season
- > Xavier will face #2 Saint Louis in the semifinals on Saturday at 3:30 p.m.
