Mack averaged 19.67 ppg. and 4.3 rpg. in leading Charlotte to a pair of wins over three games...scored a game-high 23 points and added five boards on Feb. 8 in the 49ers' 79-66 win over Dayton...had 16 points on Feb. 11 in Charlotte's 69-61 loss at Saint Louis...scored 20 points and grabbed five rebounds as the 49ers turned aside GW on Feb. 11, 69-51...all five of his 20-point performances this season have come in A-10 play...earns his first career A-10 Player of the Week honor.

• With 94 blocks and 44 steals entering the team's Feb. 18 contest versus URI, UMass senior **Tony Gaffney** is vying to become the first player nationally since Shelden Williams (Duke, 2005-06) to register 100 blocks and 50 steals in a season.

• The Atlantic 10 is the eighth-ranked conference in the RPI by collegerpi.com thru games of Feb. 13.

• Dayton is 16-0 this season when holding the lead with five minutes remaining in the game, while its 18-game home-winning streak is tops in the A-10.

• Richmond edged Duquesne on Feb. 11, 71-67, to improve to 12-0 versus the Dukes since the Spiders joined the A-10 in 2001-02. Prior to joining the Conference, UR was 0-8 all-time versus Duquesne.

NEWS FROM AROUND THE ATLANTIC 10

HONOR ROLL: Dayton sophomore forward **Chris Wright** averaged 13.7 points and 5.7 rebounds over three contests, while freshman swingman **Chris Johnson** averaged seven points and five boards...sophomore guard **Mike Moore** of Fordham averaged 22.5 points and 9.5 boards in a pair of games...La Salle junior **Rodney Green** averaged 17 points and seven rebounds in leading the Explorers to wins over GW and Saint Joseph's...senior forward **Tony Gaffney** of UMass averaged 16 points and 11.3 rebounds over three games, including scoring a career-best 21 points at St. Bonaventure on Feb. 14...Rhode Island senior guard **Jimmy Baron** averaged 17.3 points while shooting 19-of-30 from the field over three games...sophomore guard **Kevin Anderson** matched his career high with 24 points on Feb. 14 in Richmond's 69-63 loss at Dayton...St. Bonaventure freshman forward **Andrew Nicholson** averaged 14.5 points and eight rebounds in a pair of games...senior guard **Kevin Lisch** averaged 19.3 points and 6.3 rebounds over three games...Temple senior guard **Dionte Christmas** averaged 19 points and eight rebounds in a pair of wins...freshman guard **Brian Redford** scored a season-high 15 points on Feb. 14 in Xavier's 88-53 win over Fordham.

DAYTON BY NUMBERS: Dayton is 9-0 this season in games decided by five points or less, good for tops in the nation. UD is 37-5 with sophomore forward **Chris Wright** in the lineup, 7-1 this season versus teams in the top 100 of the RPI thru games of Feb. 14 and 19-0 when outrebounding its opponent.

AND ONE: Duquesne senior guard **Aaron Jackson** has converted all 14 of his conventional three-point play opportunities this season and owns a streak of 22 straight entering the Dukes' Feb. 15 contest versus Temple.

POINT PRESENCE: Massachusetts senior guard **Chris Lowe** scored his 1,000th career point on Feb. 4 in the Minutemen's 71-64 win over Richmond. Vying to become the first player in A-10 annals to lead the assists three times, he is just seventh player in league history and first at UMass with 1,000 career points and 600 career assists. Lowe's 628 career assists stand second to Carl Smith (633) in program annals.

HOME SUPREMACY: Xavier will enter its Feb. 22 contest versus George Washington at Cintas Center riding a 22-game home-winning streak in A-10 play. Temple holds the record with 34 consecutive home wins in Conference play (Dec. 10, 1987 - Feb. 19, 1991), while UMass won 24 straight home league contests from Jan. 15, 1992, to Feb. 14, 1995. Meanwhile, Dayton is undefeated (14-0) at home this season and boasts a 16-game home winning streak, the longest active streak in the Conference and tops in program history.

20-20 VISION: Xavier has reached the 20-win mark for the fourth consecutive season and 12th time in the last 13 years, while Dayton has recorded its seventh 20-win campaign over the last 10 years.

SHINING BRIGHT: Former A-10 standouts and *Associated Press* National Players of the Year **Jameer Nelson** of Saint Joseph's and Xavier's **David West** have been named to the NBA All-Star team. The contest will be held Feb. 15 in Phoenix. It marks Nelson's first All-Star selection, while West earns his second straight honor. West earned A-10 and AP Player of the honors in 2003 and is league's all-time leading rebounder (1,309). Nelson was tabbed the 2004 A-10 and AP Player of the Year and led SJU to the Elite Eight.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS: Rhode Island senior **Jimmy Baron** ranks first in program history and third in A-10 annals with 326 career three-pointers. Baron boasts 17 career performances with at least five field goals from beyond the arc and nailed eight three's at Duke on Nov. 16, the most by an opposing player in the history of Cameron Indoor Stadium. STRAIGHT SHOOTER: Saint Joseph's senior forward **Ahmad Nivins** seeks to join former George Washington standout Alexander Koul (1995-97) as the only players in A-10 history to lead the league in field goal percentage three consecutive years. Nivins shot .647 (165-of-255) from the field a year ago. The Jersey City, N.J., native has made 157-of-244 shots through the Hawks' first 24 contests and leads the league with 16 double-doubles. Nivins has scored in double figures in 81 of his 117 career games and has reached double figures in rebounds 29 times, including 16 times this season, which is tops in the league. He also boasts 26 career double-doubles, while his five A-10 Player of the Week honors this season are tied with former TU standout Mardy Collins for the fourth-highest single-season total in league annals.

SELECT COMPANY: Temple senior guard **Dionte Christmas** averaged a league-best 19.7 points last season to become just the third player in Conference history to lead the Atlantic 10 in scoring in successive years. The two other players to hold that distinction are John Battle of Rutgers (1984-85) and St. Bonaventure's Earl Belcher (1980-81). With 10 career A-10 Player of the Week honors, Christmas trails only Xavier's David West (14) and Jameer Nelson of Saint Joseph's (13) for the most honors in league history.

EXPLORING NEW HEIGHTS: **Rodney Green** scored 20 points in La Salle's 75-68 win over Saint Joseph's on Feb. 14. It marked the junior guard's 10th 20-point performance of the season. By comparison, the Philadelphia, Pa., native scored 20 or more points just three times all of last season. Green is averaging 17.0 ppg., up from 13.4 ppg. a year ago.

DANDY ANDY: St. Bonaventure freshman forward **Andrew Nicholson** leads all freshmen nationally in blocked shots (77) and field goal percentage (.621) entering the Bonnies' Feb. 14 versus Massachusetts. Named the A-10 Rookie of the Week a program-record six times, Nicholson's nine blocks at Bucknell on Dec. 30 mark the highest single-game total in Division I this season. UMass forward **Tony Gaffney** also registered nine blocks on Dec. 6 versus Boston College.

PASSING FANCY: Charlotte junior guard **DiJuan Harris** registered a career-best 15 assists on Feb. 14 in the 49ers' 69-51 win over GW. The last A-10 player to record 15 or more assists in a game was La Salle's Julian Blanks versus Rhode Island on Feb. 6, 2001. Harris has dished out 10 or more assists a league-best eight times this season.

The Atlantic 10 won 16 games versus BCS teams in non-conference action during the regular season, the most of any non-BCS league and good for fifth nationally. In addition, nine different A-10 teams registered at least one victory over a BCS foe, with Xavier's six wins leading the league.

TRIPLE FIGURES: Charlotte's 70-53 win over Winthrop on Jan. 31 raised the league's total to 115 non-conference wins this season, the second-highest total in league annals. The A-10 also surpassed the 100-win total in non-conference play in 2007 (104) and 2008 (130). A-10 teams have amassed 16 wins over BCS conference teams thus far, which ranks fifth nationally.

SOPHOMORE DISTINCTION: Rhode Island sophomore guard **Marquis Jones** is the first Rhode Island sophomore since Howard Smith (2000-01) to register at least 100 assists in a season. Jones leads the Rams in assists with 108, good for fifth in the A-10. Smith had 105 helpers in his second season.

FOUL FREE: Saint Joseph's senior forward **Ahmad Nivins** has registered 47 blocks and committed just 49 fouls thru the Hawks' first 24 games this season. What makes his low foul total even more remarkable is that Nivins leads the A-10 in minutes (39.5 mpg.) and has played 948 out of a possible 985 minutes.

RANK & FILE: Duquesne's 72-68 win over then-No. 9/9 Xavier on Feb. 7 marked its first victory over a top 10 team since a 91-84 win over No. 10 (AP) Florida State on Dec. 15, 1992, and ended the Dukes' 24-game losing streak against ranked teams since an 88-72 victory over then-No. 16 (AP) Xavier on Jan. 25, 1997.

MODEL OF CONSISTENCY: Charlotte has made at least one three-pointer in 607 consecutive games – a streak that ranks in the top 10 nationally and dates back to 1989.

FROM WALKING TO RUNNING: Duquesne walk-on junior guard **Jason Duty**, who joined the team on the day of the 2006-07 season opener only after a campus shooting left the roster decimated, may be the feel-good story in the Atlantic 10 this season. Duty, who gave up a gig as a singer and guitar player for a band called 'Mark this Day' to give Division I basketball a try, has made himself into one of the top three-point shooters in the league. He currently ranks sixth in the Conference in three-point percentage at .412 (40-of-97), is shooting .879 (29-of-33) from the foul line, ranks second on the team in career games played (68) and third in career starts with 38.

SENIORS WITH STYLE: Temple's **Dionte Christmas** and **Jimmy Baron** of Rhode Island are among 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the award was launched during the 2001-02 season to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who remain committed to their university and pursue the many rewards that a senior season and complete college education brings. Previous A-10 recipients include Xavier's David West (2003) and Jameer Nelson of Saint Joseph's (2004).

ROAD WARRIORS: St. Bonaventure opened the season with seven consecutive road victories for the first time in program history, and its seven road wins mark their highest total since the 2001-02 campaign.

FAMILY AFFAIR: Saint Louis senior guard **Kevin Lisch** and sister Theresa are one of just four known sister-brother combinations in NCAA Division I to score at least 1,000 points at the same school. Kevin is just the second player in program history to rank in the top 10 in both scoring (seventh) and assists (10th).

MUSCLING UP: According to RealTime RPI, the Atlantic 10 ranks fourth among Division I conferences in Strength of Schedule. In addition, A-10 teams faced 18 ranked opponents in non-conference action. Temple has played five non-league teams who reached the NCAA Tournament a year ago, while Xavier boasts six wins over BCS-conference teams this season, which is tied with Gonzaga for tops nationally.

RETURN TO SENDER: Dayton tied a program record with nine blocked shots in its 71-58 win over #14/#14 Xavier on Feb. 11. **Chris Wright** led UD with three blocks in the game.

PINT-SIZED PLAYMAKER: One of the more improved players in the A-10 thus far this season is Charlotte junior **DiJuan Harris**. The 5-9 guard is averaging a league-best 6.83 apg., up from 3.2 a year ago. The last Charlotte player to average more than five assists in a season was Sean Colson (8.0 apg.) in 1997-98.

RARE AIR: Senior forward **Kahiem Seawright** recorded his 100th career block on Jan. 31 in Rhode Island's 98-88 (OT) win over La Salle. Seawright joins former Xavier standout - and two-time All-Star - David West as the only A-10 players since 1996-97 to register at least 1,000 points, 750 rebounds, 200 assists and 100 career blocks.

HIGH FLYERS: Dayton has amassed a program-record 89 dunks on the year, surpassing its previous record of 61 after just 26 games this season.

PUTTING UP THEIR DUKES: Duquesne is off to its best start since 1980-81 and the catalyst for the Dukes is senior guard **Aaron Jackson**, a three-time A-10 Player of the Week selection this season. Jackson topped the 100-assist mark for the third time in four seasons and is just the sixth player in team annals to accomplish the feat. He was one of 10 players recently named to the SportsIllustrated.com All-Underrated Team.

SPECIAL SATURDAY: GW senior **Rob Diggs** moved into fourth place in program annals with 129 career blocks while becoming the 41st player in GW history to reach the 1,000-point milestone in the Colonials' 87-62 win over Fordham on Feb. 7.

MORE THAN REGULATION: Rhode Island's three overtime games (GW, LAS, SJU) in A-10 play thus far marks the first time since 1990-91 that the Rams have had that many league contests go to extra periods.

START ME UP: Dayton junior **Kurt Huelsman** has started every game of his collegiate career, a span of 91 consecutive contests thru games of Feb. 14, while URI senior **Kahiem Seawright** has also made 91 consecutive starts.

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CHAMPIONSHIP CHATTER: The Atlantic 10 Conference and CBS Sports announced a multi-year agreement for CBS to air the league's men's basketball championship final, beginning in 2010. The A-10 also announced a new format for the men's basketball championship to coincide with the 2010 title game being moved to Sunday on CBS Sports. The new format will continue to see the top 12 teams participate with seeds 1 through 4 receiving an opening round bye; however, the four opening round games will move to the campuses of the higher remaining seeded teams. Winners of each game will advance to the quarter-finals at a site scheduled to be announced later this winter for 2010 and beyond.

LIGHTS...CAMERA...ACTION: Temple and Massachusetts knocked off ranked opponents on Dec. 13 during an ESPN afternoon doubleheader. The Owls turned aside eighth-ranked Tennessee, 88-72, notching their first win over a top 10 team since a 68-53 win over No. 6 George Washington in the quarterfinals of the 2006 A-10 Championship. UMass edged No. 25 (AP)/No. 23 (ESPN/USA Today) and defending national champion Kansas, 616-60, at The Sprint Center in Kansas City, Mo. It marked the first victory over a ranked foe by the Minutemen outside their home state since they downed fourth-ranked Georgetown, 86-62, in the Regional Finals of the 1996 NCAA Tournament.

SPANNING THE GLOBE: Fourteen student-athletes from overseas are currently on Atlantic 10 rosters and each has already appeared in a game this season.
