## STARTING LINEUP

Combined, Atlantic 10 programs have played the fourth most difficult strength of schedule this year. There are six A-10 teams that have a strength of schedule that ranks in the top 50, and four of those are in the top 25 (Dayton-16, VCU-17, Saint Joseph's-24 and Rhode Island-25). The A-10 also has 15 wins against the top 100 RPI teams.

The Atlantic 10 has started a new initiative for the 2016-17 season - streaming a package of 15 games on Facebook Live. The A-10 is the first conference to use the social media network to distribute a set of games. Wednesday's Vanderbilt at Dayton game is the next schedule Facebook Live stream. SportsPITTSBURGH has signed on as the presenting sponsor for the Facebook Live games.

The A-10 boasts two of the best scoring duos in the nation. Davidson's Jack Gibbs and Peyton Aldridge combine to score 43.0 points per game for the Wildcats. St. Bonaventure's Jaylen Adams and Matt Mobley tally 42.6 points per game together. The two duos rank 2-3 for scoring in Division I.

Davidson Men's Basketball Coach Bob McKillop is one of 10 people selected to serve on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Competition Committee. McKillop joins another head coach, four Division I NCAA staff members, three members of the public with significant men's basketball experience and a student-athlete on the newly-formed body.

Two A-10 teams are on extended winning streaks. George Mason has claimed eight straight victories. George Washington has won three in a row. Four other A-10 teams have won back-to-back games: Duquesne, UMass, St. Bonaventure and VCU.

There are eight Atlantic 10 teams in the top 125 of the RPI. Of those eight, Dayton, Rhode Island and VCU are in the top 50. There are also 10 Atlantic 10 teams in the top 125 of the Sagarin ratings and the Pomeroy Ratings.

The A-10 graduated 86 percent of the men's basketball student-athletes according to the latest NCAA Graduation Success Report (GSR). This is an impressive 11 percentage point improvement over last year's report. Collectively, the Atlantic 10 men's basketball GSR is six percentage points higher than the national average of 80.

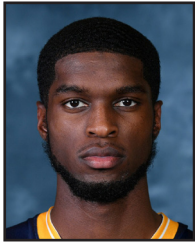

## PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### B.J. Johnson, La Salle

Junior | Forward | Philadelphia, Pa.



Johnson registered a career-high 35 points, including 28 after halftime to lead La Salle to an 84-80 win over reigning Atlantic Sun champion Florida Gulf Coast on Saturday. The left-handed forward shot 10-of-16 (.625) from the field and 12-for-14 (.857) from the charity stripe en route to his best scoring output as a collegian, eclipsing his prior high of 24 set earlier this year against Texas Southern. The Philadelphia native hit back-to-back 3-pointers with his team trailing by six in the second half, and scored the final six points of the game to seal

the victory. Johnson leads the team and ranks in the top 10 in the Atlantic 10 in scoring at 19.9 points per game.

## ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

### Luwane Pipkins, Massachusetts

Freshman | Guard | Chicago, Ill.



Pipkins averaged 19.0 points per game during a pair of Gotham Classic victories. The guard from Chicago shot 50 percent from the floor (14-28) and chipped in four assists, two steals and two rebounds per game. He scored nine of his 11 points against North Carolina A&T during the final eight minutes of the game. That included a 3-pointer that gave the Minutemen the lead for good, and a pair of fast break layups that helped sealed the win. He also dished out five assists versus the Aggies. Pipkins followed with a personal-best 27

points against Kennesaw State, including a program record-tying eight made 3-pointers. He scored all four of his first-half triples in succession, turning a five-point Massachusetts deficit into a lead the team did not relinquish the rest of the game.

A-10 COACHING

HISTORY IN THE MAKING

The Atlantic 10 has long been a hotbed of head coaches. From John Chaney and John Calapari to John Beilein and the late Rick Majerus, there have been several legendary coaches whose reputation as bench bosses was forged or refined in the A-10.

COACHING LEGENDS

A handful of the current A-10 coaches rank among the all-time coaching leaders in career wins. Six coaches, Bob McKillop, Jim Ferry, Dave Paulsen, Dr. John Giannini, Phil Martelli and Travis Ford all have at least 300 wins while Martelli, Giannini and Paulsen have over 400 wins to their name. And Bob McKillop is a member of the exclusive 500-win club. Paulsen and Giannini won NCAA titles in Division III while Ford tallied his career wins at a number of schools, including UMass. McKillop and Martelli have had the opportunity to earn all of their victories at their respective institutions. Nine A-10 coaches (more than half the league) have more than 200 career wins.

ATLANTIC 10 TEAMS  
IN THE POSTSEASON

The 14 member institutions of the Atlantic 10 all have successful winning traditions on a national stage. Through their history, they have combined for 333 postseason appearances and the league and its members have made nearly 200 trips to the NCAA Men's Basketball Tournament. Those appearances have resulted in a national champion, multiple national runners up and numerous Final Four, Elite Eight and Sweet 16 appearances.

Since the 2007-08 season, the Atlantic 10 has sent 66 teams to the postseason, including 33 appearances in the NCAA Tournament by A-10 teams in that nine-year timeframe, 24 of which have come via at-large bids. The Atlantic 10 has sent a team to the Sweet 16 in seven of the last nine years and each of the 14 the current members have made the postseason during that span. The conference also has won the NIT twice during that time frame, and played in the semifinals or finals in New York two other times.

*George Washington claimed the National Invitational Tournament (NIT) title in March with a win over Valparaiso. It was the Atlantic 10's second NIT crown in seven years and the eighth overall by an A-10 team. The victory meant both major basketball championships, the NCAA and NIT, were won by basketball-centric conferences in 2016.*
