Southern California University of Health Sciences Welcomes Largest Incoming Class in Three Years

Whittier CA, September 20, 2009: Southern California University of Health Sciences (SCU) welcomes its fall 2009 matriculating students. This group consists of 69 students enrolled in the doctor of chiropractic (DC) program, 25 students enrolled in the acupuncture and Oriental medicine (AOM) program, and 19 students enrolled in the dual degree (combined DC/AOM) program.

The total number of incoming students in this cohort is the highest since 2006, and represents a 24% increase over the fall 2008 count and 41% increase over fall 2007 count.
