What type of tickets are available?

General Admission \$15 for adults (\$20 at the gate)

\$8 for children* (\$10 at the gate)

Premium Box Seats** \$25 (includes admission to the show)

Flight Line Club*** \$95 for adults (includes admission to the show)

\$50 for children* (includes admission to the show)

*Children prices are for ages 4-12. Three (3) and under are free.

**Premium Box Seats Guarantee yourself a great seat close to the flight line to enjoy the

show. The Premium Box Beats are assigned seats on the tarmac. Children 3 and under are free and lap only. If you wish to have a seat for your 3 year old or under, a ticket needs to be purchased.

No umbrellas are allowed in this area.

***Flight Line Club Enjoy all the action of the air show in the comfort of this Flight Line

Chalet, and feel the rumbling of the planes as they take off and land right in front of you! In the Flight Line Club Chalet, experience the comfort of the front line seating in front of the U.S. Air Force Thunderbirds, with a catered lunch and unlimited soft drinks. Beer

and wine will be available at the Flight Line Club Chalet. (VIP Parking is included with presale tickets only)

What's up with parking?

Parking is free. All parking will be on the airfield and space is set aside for buses/RVs. You will be directed by the parking attendants.

When do the gates open?

Gates open at 8:00AM. Static displays, kid's zone and exhibits will open at 8:00AM. The parachute jump with the American flag and the National Anthem will be at approximately 11:30AM. Performers start immediately after that and continue to about 4:30PM. Air Show savvy fans know to arrive well before scheduled flying begins.

Are there any group discounts available?

Can I fly in?

You may fly in to Smyrna by 10:00AM either Saturday or Sunday. You will be directed to park at the FBOs on the western side of the field. You may pre-purchase your tickets online or buy at the FBO (they'll cost more the day of the show). The FBOs will take care of your plane and transport you to the eastern side of the field for the air show. They will pick you up when it's over and bring you back to your plane. You can expect departure about 5:00PM.

About NOTAMs:

NOTAMs will be issued throughout the Air Show week, but we are scheduled to close the Airport on Saturday and Sunday at 11:00AM and re-open at 5:00PM.

From Nashville: take I-24E to Sam Ridley Parkway. Exit 66.

From East: take I-24W to Lee Victory Parkway, Exit 70. Follow the Smyrna Airport signs.
