Memory Verse: "For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received, that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures." 1 Corinthians 15:3, 4.

Monday: Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-2. What are some practical ways you can renew yourself in the wonderful message of the Gospel each day?

Tuesday: Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-8. How does trust in the God/man Jesus Christ, who rose from the dead, differ from a "religion" or "belief systems?"

Wednesday: Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-8. How should the fact of Christ's resurrection change our outlook on life and our daily behaviors?

Thursday: Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-8. In what ways does the historical evidence for Jesus' resurrection reassure us of the firm foundations of our faith?

Friday: Read 1 Corinthians 15:9-11. How can you reveal God's work in you through the Gospel to other people? Be specific.

Saturday: Read 1 Corinthians 15:12-34. Reflect on the absolute necessity to our faith of the resurrection to new life. Invite someone in your FRAN (Friends, Relatives, Associates and Neighbors) to the service tomorrow to hear the good news of the resurrection.
