REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

Monday: Read Acts 19:1-7. Name one Christian in your life that has a faulty or incomplete understanding of the faith. How might you help them?

Tuesday: Read Acts 19:8-10. Spend some time reflecting and praying about whether your own heart is hardening, or has grown hard, toward spiritual authorities, influences, or teachings.

Wednesday: Read Acts 19:11-17. Are you invoking the name of Jesus without having repented of your sin and putting your faith in Him alone as your sin-bearing Lord and Savior? Are you a Christian using Jesus' name in inappropriate ways, for selfish purposes?

Thursday: Read Acts 19:18-20. What secret sin(s) need to be brought to the light and burned in your own life?

Friday: Read Acts 19:21-22. Do you have a Timothy or Erastus for your life and ministry? If not, who might you be able to disciple who could in turn help you in the pursuit of God's kingdom?

Saturday: Read Acts 19:23-41. Pray for our time together and any unsaved in our midst!
