#### **Reflection Questions**

**Monday:** Read Luke 2:8-14 and note the connection of joy from the angel and the message of glory to God from the multitude of heavenly host. Meditate on: God is most glorified in us when we are most satisfied in Him.

**Tuesday:** The Gospels of Matthew, Luke, and John each describe the birth of Jesus Christ from a different perspective. Read Matt 1:18-25, which emphasizes the virginity of Mary and the role of the Holy Spirit in fulfillment of prophecy regarding Christ's birth.

**Wednesday:** Read Luke 2:1-20, which stresses the providence of God working through ordinary circumstances and the obedience of Mary and Joseph to care for the newborn Savior of the world.

**Thursday:** Read John 1:1-14, in which John declares the divinity of Christ and the addition of humanity when He became flesh.

**Friday:** How do the three accounts of Christ's birth (Matt 1:18-25; Luke 2:1-20; John 1:1-14) harmonize and what do they collectively reveal about the identity of Jesus Christ?

**Saturday:** Read 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11 and bring a friend with you to church tomorrow—the last Sunday worship of 2018.
