REFLECTION AND APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Monday: Read Matt 7:1-6 and outline the major sections of the passage. Put into one sentence the essence of the message Jesus gives us.

Tuesday: Read Matt 7:1-2. What is the difference between judgment and discernment? How does Hebrews 5:14; Matt 18:15-20 and 1 Corinthians 5:1-13 relate to Matt 7:1-2?

Wednesday: Read Matt 7:3-5. How do Galatians 6:1-5; 1 Cor 4:1-5 and Ephesians 4:32-5:2 relate to Matt 7:3-5? What is the difference between reviling and reproving?

Thursday: Read Matt 7:6. How do Jude 22-23; Titus 3:9-11; Luke 10:10-12; 22:8-11; Acts 13:46, 51; and 2 Timothy 2:24-26 relate to Matt 7:6?

Friday: Read Matt 7:1-6 and outline specific principles for wisely relating to others from the passage. How does the gospel of Jesus Christ shape your principles?

Saturday: Read Matt 7:7-12 and bring a friend with you to church. Pray for specific people to invite on Easter Sunday.
